Subject: FY 2006-07 Year-End Budget Amendments

Agenda Item No. 8(L)(1)(C)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the attached resolution amending the FY 2006-07 Adopted Budget to allocate funds among various County agencies from appropriate sources.

BACKGROUND

State law prohibits departmental spending in excess of Board approved appropriations. However, during the course of the year, extraordinary events can occur that would result in a department exceeding its budget without an additional appropriation of funds unless it was to reduce or suspend services. Historically, recommendations have been submitted to the Board to adjust budgets to account for such events. Technical adjustments require a year-end General Fund budget amendment. As has been past practice, certain reserves, such as those for public safety, energy, activation, and Florida Retirement System costs are budgeted separately from departmental allocations with the intent to distribute these revenues through the budget amendment process. Pursuant to Ordinance 07-45, also included are the budget line item transaction re-appropriations that require the Board's review and approval.

Community-based Organizations

As the Board was apprised at budget hearings in September and in the FY 2005-06 General Fund Year-End Budget, the budget for community-based organizations (CBOs) funding must be amended to extend the contract award by three months in order to align the public service grants, and all other grant funding with the County's fiscal year (\$5.956 million). In addition, when Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the Public Service contracts was replaced with general fund subsidy, three organizations were inadvertently left off the list of grants, Unidad of Miami Beach, Inc. (\$7,500), Community Economic Development Improvement Association (CEDIA) (\$30,000), and New Jerusalem Community Development Corporation (\$21,000) as well as the costs associated with audit requirements reflected in the public service agreements (\$70,000). The Office of Community and Economic Development has indicated that the allocations provided to the Community Economic Development Improvement Association (CEDIA) (\$41,500) needs to be transferred to Galata, Inc. who will serve as a fiscal administrator for CEDIA. During the December 19, 2006 meeting of the Board, through the approval of Resolution R 1423-06, five public service grants were added to the list of public service grants being transferred to the general fund category: Best Buddies (\$10,000), Fifty-Five Years and Up (\$20,000), Florida Venture Foundation (\$15,000), Little Havana Activities and Nutrition Center (\$25,000), and Victim Services (\$10,000). The attached (Attachment 1) list incorporates all the above-mentioned changes.

Florida Healthy Kids Corporation

The contract between Miami-Dade County and Florida Healthy Kids Corporation to provide health coverage for non-Title XXI children is not funded in FY 2007-08. As previously reported, enrollment of additional children into this program has been restricted since July 1, 2000 resulting in the gradual reduction of enrollees. As part of the FY 2006-07 budget, the Board approved an appropriation of \$2.545 million for this program; however, the reduction in enrollment resulted in a reduction in the amount of local funds necessary to provide this coverage in FY 2006-07. As of September 30, 2007, there is an unspent balance of \$264,000. Approval to extend the contract with Florida Healthy Kids Corporation into FY 2007-08 until such time as the balance of these funds is expended is recommended.

Animal Services

The Animal Services Department requires an amendment of \$10,000 to cover unrealized code violation fine revenues. Funding will be provided by the Countywide General Fund.

Board of County Commissioners

The budgets for the Board of County Commissioners and its divisions will be amended by \$3.724 million for the allocation of unexpended FY 2005-06 year-end office balances.

Elections

The Elections Department requires an amendment of \$1.381 million to cover costs associated with an unbudgeted special election in District 13 in December 2006 and one unbudgeted countywide special election in January 2007.

Housing Agency

As noted in the accompanying supplemental budget item, analysis continues regarding the financial status of the Miami-Dade Housing Agency (MDHA). The MDHA staff is in the process of finalizing FY 2006-07 year end adjustments and is working closely with a new audit firm. Subsequent to the takeover by USHUD, the staff has been asked to review the FY 2005-06 year end statements as well. At this point, we can report that MDHA posted expenditures in excess of the FY 2006-07 authorized budget of \$6.998 million; in addition to \$969,000 of unrealized revenues requiring a total amendment of \$7.967 million. The excess expenditures in FY 2006-07 occurred due to payments for services from FY 2005-06 that were processed in FY 2006-07 (\$2.178 million), additional costs associated with the operations of the Helen Sawyer Assisted Living Facility administered by the Department of Human Services (\$841,000), additional costs for security, janitorial services, elevator repairs, and other operating costs (\$3.979 million). It is recommended that these expenditures be funded by the Countywide General Fund. Any further adjustments that may be required following approval of these items as a result of on-going audits will be addressed as part of the FY 2008-09 Budget.

Metro-Miami Action Plan Trust – Martin Luther King (MLK), Jr. Academy

The Metro-Miami Action Plan Trust MLK, Jr. Academy requires a budget amendment of \$42,000 to cover unrealized revenues from low student enrollment, which will be funded from the countywide General Fund.

Office of Community and Economic Development

As the Board was apprised at its September 2006 budget hearings and through correspondence sent by the County to U.S. Housing and Urban Development, the County exceeded its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Service cap in both FY 2005 and FY 2006. A payment in the amount of \$2.4 million was made to the Miami-Dade County CDBG Line of Credit to address the CY

2005 over-expenditure. In order to address the CY 2006 over-expenditure an amendment of \$4.481 million is needed to authorize the payment of \$797,000 to the CDBG Line of Credit and \$3.684 million to authorize payments made to agencies for the period of September 2006 through December 2007. This funding has been allocated to support affordable housing activities through the CY 2008 Action Plan, adopted by the BCC on November 6, 2007.

Team Metro

Team Metro requires a budget amendment of \$344,000 to cover unrealized lien revenue collections from code enforcement activities due to a significant decline in real estate transactions. Liens are often satisfied upon transfer of title to the property. The total revenue shortfall was \$910,000; however, the department was able to minimize the impact as a result of increased direct sales and other miscellaneous revenues (\$333,000), and a reduction of departmental expenditures (\$233,000).

Budget Line Item Transaction Appropriations

Miami-Dade County Ordinance 07-45 now requires the disclosure of line item expenditures that exceeded budgeted allocation and the proper line item adjustments based on pre-established criteria. No transactions of this type had occurred at the time we reported this information to the BCC pursuant to the date established is the ordinance. In general, expenditure transactions beyond the stipulated line item budget are likely to occur in the last quarter of the year, when the majority of overdue transactions are posted in anticipation of the year end closeout.

Attachment 2 lists all the transactions that require Board approval for the re-appropriation of budget as a result of exceeding the 10 percent threshold and/or the movement of personnel expenditures to other line item categories. In addition, Attachment 3 lists in detail the department line item appropriations that were administratively approved to reflect the proper expenditure categorization and did not exceed the ten percent threshold. Both attachments detail the department name, the fund type where the over expenditure occurred, the spending category, the total budget for the department, the amount of the adjustment(s), the percent of the budget it represents, the spending category where the re-appropriation will occur, and a description of the adjustment. Through the approval of this item, the Board authorizes the Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) to process all budget transactions required to execute the year-end amendments.
