

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF REPOSITIONING COMPUTERS AND PRINTERS LOCATED WITHIN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY POLICE PATROL VEHICLES TO ALLOW A SECOND OFFICER TO SIT IN THE FRONT RIGHT PASSENGER SEAT

WHEREAS, this Board believes that it is essential to do everything in its power to protect law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, one way to assist in providing this protection may be to allow for a second law enforcement officer to be able to sit in the front passenger seat in marked patrol vehicles; and

WHEREAS, by repositioning this equipment it would give the Director of the Miami-Dade County Police Department another tool in safeguarding law enforcement officers assigned to patrol high crime areas as it would allow for two officers to be positioned in patrol vehicles when deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, presently Miami-Dade County marked patrol vehicles have both computers and printers located in the right front passenger seat restricting the ability of a second officer to comfortably sit in the right front passenger seat,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Manager to study the feasibility and advisability of repositioning the computers and printers within the County's marked patrol vehicles to allow a second officer to sit in the right

front passenger seat. The County Manager shall report to this Board the results of the study and recommendations within ninety (90) days of the adoption of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Vice-Chairwoman Barbara J. Jordan and offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption.
