

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO TRANSFER THE ALLOCATION PROCESS FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM FUNDING BACK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO UTILIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO PREPARE THE REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS (RFPs) FOR COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Summer Youth Employment Program each year has enabled approximately 7,000 youths living at or below the poverty level in Miami-Dade County to have a summer job experience; and

WHEREAS, the job experience gained by participants in the program teaches successful employment skills and provides a service to the community in a structured work environment; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-1395-06 transferred the allocation process for the Summer Youth Employment Program to the Alliance for Human Services beginning the summer of 2008 going forward; and

WHEREAS, due to changes in the relationship between Miami-Dade County and the Alliance for Human Services, the Board desires that allocation of funding for the Summer Youth Employment Program be transferred from the Alliance for Human Services back to the Department of Human Services commencing with the Summer Youth Program for summer 2008 going forward; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The County Mayor or his designee is directed to transfer the allocation of funding for the Summer Youth Employment Program from the Alliance for Human Services back to the Department of Human Services.

Section 2. The County Mayor or his designee is directed to utilize the Department of Human Services to prepare the Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for Community-based Organizations for the administration of the Summer Youth Employment Program for summer 2008 going forward.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
