

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the American Cancer Society for their Relay For Life of East Kendall event scheduled for March 15, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$866 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of their stage. This event will be funded from the District 8 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2007-08, the American Cancer Society has received \$40,000 from the following District discretionary reserve funds: \$5,000 from District 1, \$5,000 from District 3, \$5,000 from District 7, \$5,000 from District 8, \$5,000 from District 9, and \$15,000 from District 10.
