

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 26, 2008 WALK AMERICA EVENT SPONSORED BY THE MARCH OF DIMES FOUNDATION, INC. A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,223.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE

WHEREAS, the March of Dimes Foundation, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the April 26, 2008 Walk America event in an amount not to exceed \$28,223.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the Walk America event is a fundraiser walk that raises money to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects, premature births and infant mortality; and

WHEREAS, the March of Dimes Foundation, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Walk America is a major event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$28,223.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,


Dear Commissioner Heyman:

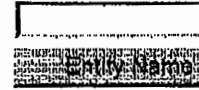

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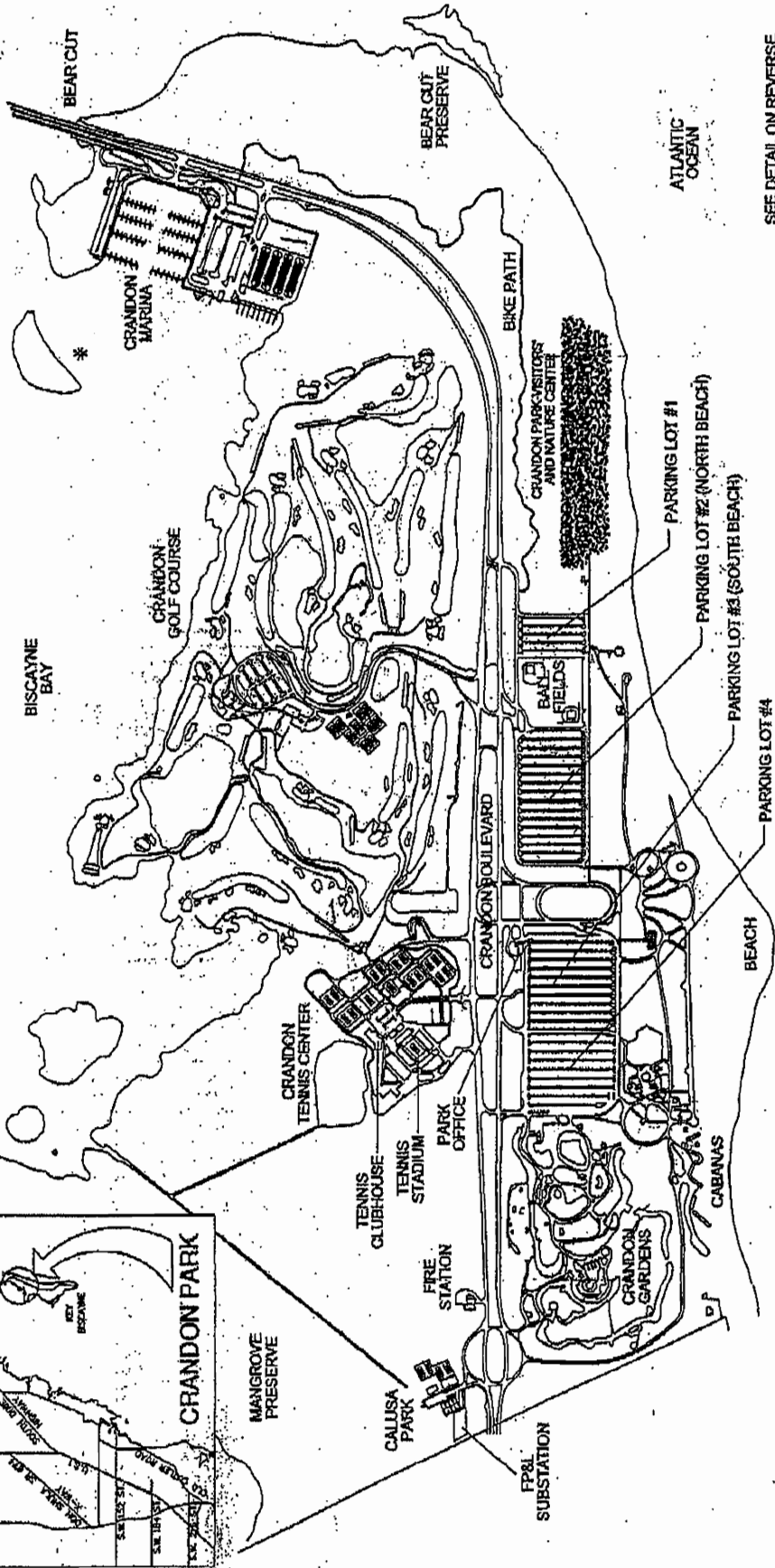
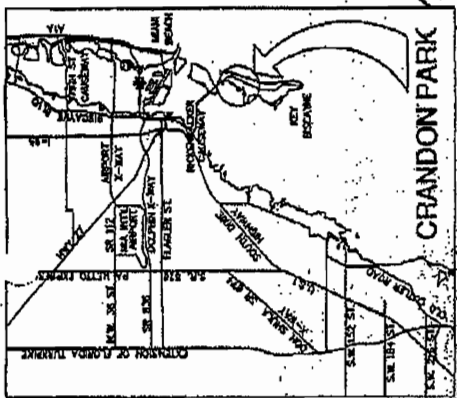

Subject: Countywide In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the March of Dimes Foundation, Inc. for the Walk America event scheduled for April 26, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$17,233 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of the Crandon Park facility to include parking spaces for 3,000 cars, area fee coverage, parking attendant fees and permit application fees, and \$11,000 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services for a total in-kind amount of \$28,223. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2007-08, the March of Dimes Foundation, Inc. has received \$12,750 from the General Fund, \$5,000 from District 12 discretionary reserve, and \$1,200 from District 4 office funds.
