

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CODESIGNATION  
OF SW 122<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE FROM SW 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO  
CORAL WAY AS GLADEVIEW AVENUE

**WHEREAS**, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from SW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to Coral Way as Gladeview Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, Gladeview Baptist Church, on the corner of Coral Way and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, has been a landmark in the community since it was founded in 1965. The name “Gladeview” was chosen because at that time there was nothing in the area except for the neighboring Everglades; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1968, Gladeview Baptist Kindergarten opened its doors to 3 and 4 year olds. Under the leadership of Principal Janice Roach, the school added additional grades and is currently educating from preschool through eighth grade. Forty years later, the school known as Gladeview Christian School is proud to offer excellence in education under the new principal, Luis Couvertiver; and

**WHEREAS**, Gladeview will be celebrating their 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year, and the new Pastor, Michael Rodriquez, is looking forward to further growth. The school is enjoying a new library and classrooms with the completion of a new building, and plans for a 400-seat auditorium are underway; and

**WHEREAS**, Gladeview anticipates many more years of service to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the Gladeview Church and School with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of S.W. 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from SW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to Coral Way as Gladeview Avenue.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
