RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO  
DESIGNATE A PROMINENT STATE ROAD IN MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY AS "ROSENDO ROSELL ROAD"; APPROVING  
SUCH DESIGNATION

**WHEREAS**, Rosendo Rosell is a well-known and Cuban-American artist who has entertained the public with his many talents for generations; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosell has appeared on the stage, on Cuban television, and starred in motion pictures in Cuba and Mexico; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosell was born in Placetas, Las Villas, on June 25, 1918; and

**WHEREAS**, he resided in Guanabacoa, La Habana, before coming to the United States in 1960; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosell had his own orchestra before becoming a comedian, authored many folksongs, and recorded more than 20 comedy albums; and

**WHEREAS**, his performances on stage, radio and television and in films have been popular for generations; and

**WHEREAS**, the name Rosendo Rosell has always been remembered as a source of inspiration, respect and affection; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would respectfully ask that the Florida Legislature to designate a prominent state road in Miami-Dade County as "Rosendo Rosell Road",

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board:

**Section 1.** Urges the Florida Legislature to designate a prominent state road in Miami-Dade County as "Rosendo Rosell Road."

**Section 2.** Approves such designation.

**Section 3.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of the resolution to the Governor; the Senate President; the House Speaker; the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation, and the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation.

**Section 4.** Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the issues identified in section 1 above, and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2008 state legislative package.
