



RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO PASS LEGISLATION STRENGTHENING LAWS RELATED TO ASSAULT WEAPONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE "OFFICER JOSE SOMOHANO ASSAULT WEAPONS ACT"

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2007, this Board passed Resolution No. 1246-07, which urged the U.S. Congress and the Florida Legislature to impose a ban on assault weapons; and

WHEREAS, bills have been filed in the Florida Legislature for consideration during the 2008 regular session that would strengthen laws related to assault weapons though not banning them; and

WHEREAS, S.B. 1664 by Senator Larcenia Bullard and H.B. 447 by Representative Yolly Roberson entitled the "Officer Jose Somohano Assault Weapons Act" would make it a third degree felony to store or leave an assault weapon within the reach or easy access of another person if the person obtains the weapon and uses it to inflict injury or death; and

WHEREAS, S.B. 782 by Senator Gwen Margolis and H.B. 425 by Representative Evan Jenne would increase the penalties for possessing, discharging or seriously harming another person with an assault weapon; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports legislation that strengthens laws related to assault weapons,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature to pass legislation strengthening laws related to assault weapons, including but not limited to the "Officer Jose Somohano Assault Weapons Act", S.B. 1664, H.B. 447, S.B. 782 and H.B. 447 or similar legislation.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade County State Legislative Delegation, and Representative Evan Jenne.

Section 3. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the passage of the legislation set forth in Section 1 above and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2008 State Legislative Package.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
