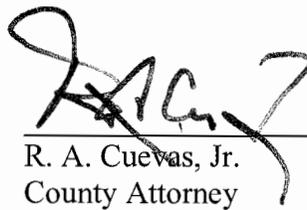

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR UNITED STATES
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S SMART
GROWTH IMPLEMENTATION ASSISTANCE RELATED
TO MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S URBAN DEVELOPMENT
BOUNDARY

WHEREAS, the Smart Growth Implementation Assistance ("SGIA") Program is an annual, competitive solicitation open to governmental units that wish to incorporate smart growth techniques into their future development; and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency's ("EPA") Office of Policy Economics and Innovation is currently seeking applications from governmental units for policy analysis and public participatory processes associated with smart growth; and

WHEREAS, selected communities receive assistance in the form of a multi-day visit from a team of national experts to work with local leaders; and

WHEREAS, at the end of the process the team submits a final report to the applicant incorporating the team's findings and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the underlying growth management policies and the process for amending the Urban Development Boundary ("UDB") line are issues that were discussed in depth by the Charter Review Task Force; and

WHEREAS, because debate surrounding the process for amendment of the UDB line is often acrimonious and divisive, the opportunity to have national experts objectively assess and analyze our UDB policies and procedures could greatly benefit the cohesiveness of our County; and

WHEREAS, this Board directs the County Mayor or his designee to submit an application in response to the EPA's SGIA 2008 Request for Applications specifically for the purpose of providing an evaluation and assessment of the County's UDB policy and the process related to the amendment of the UDB line; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports the application for the purpose provided herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or his designee to submit an application in response to the EPA's SGIA 2008 Request for Applications specifically for the purpose of providing an evaluation and assessment of the County's UDB policy and the process related to the amendment of the UDB line.
