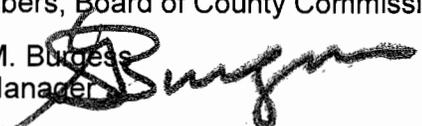

Subject: Grant Application to Florida Communities Trust (FCT) Florida Forever Program

Agenda Item No.3(J)(1)(A)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution authorizing the County Mayor or his designee to apply for up to \$1.5 million in grant funds from the Florida Department of Community Affairs for a Florida Communities Trust (FCT) Florida Forever Program Grant to acquire up to 11 acres of land adjacent to Castellow Hammock Preserve and Nature Center and further authorizing the County Mayor or his designee to receive and expend funds and execute contracts and amendments as required.

Scope

The Castellow Hammock Preserve and Nature Center is located at 21900 SW 157th Avenue within the unincorporated area of Miami-Dade County, in Commission District 8.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This grant will contribute up to \$1,500,000 toward the cost of the acquisition project. The required match will be available from the Environmentally Endangered Land Program (EEL) and is anticipated to be 38% to 49% of the total project.

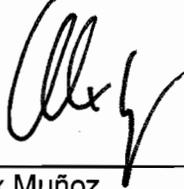
Track Record/Monitor

The FCT awarded the Park and Recreation Department (MDPR) a grant of \$1,200,000 for land acquisition at Camp Matecumbe in FY 2002-03. The proposed grant, if awarded, will be administered by Beth Wojas, Grants Administrator for MDPR.

Background

The FCT, Florida Forever Program, is a State land acquisition grant program. This program provides funding to local governments and eligible non-profit environmental organizations to acquire land for community-based parks, open space and greenways that expand outdoor recreation and natural resource protection needs identified in local government comprehensive plans. This grant application is consistent with those requirements.

The grant application is due on May 07, 2008. If the application is successful, funds will become available in September 2008.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR UP TO \$1,500,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR A FLORIDA COMMUNITIES TRUST (FCT) FLORIDA FOREVER PROGRAM GRANT TO ACQUIRE UP TO 11 ACRES OF LAND ADJACENT TO CASTELLOW HAMMOCK PRESERVE AND NATURE CENTER AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT, EXPEND FUNDS, AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND AMENDMENTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to apply for up to \$1,500,000 in grant funds from the Florida Department of Community Affairs for a Florida Communities Trust (FCT) Florida Forever Program Grant to acquire up to 11 acres of land adjacent to Castellow Hammock Preserve and Nature Center; and further authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to execute such contracts and amendments as are required by this governmental body following approval by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request; file and execute any necessary amendments to the agreement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.
