Subject: Resolution Declaring the Acquisition of Parcel 501 and four (4) year Temporary Construction Easements (TCE) Needed for Construction of the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC)/Earlington Heights Connector, a 2.4 Mile Corridor Linking the MIC to the Earlington Heights Metrorail Station Located at State Road (SR) 112 and NW 22 Avenue, to be a Public Necessity; and Authorizing the County Mayor or his designee and the County Attorney to Take Any and All Appropriate Actions to Accomplish Acquisition of the Subject Property in Fee Simple and Temporary Construction Easements, by Donation, Purchase at Values Established by Appraisals or by Eminent Domain Court Proceedings Including Declarations of Taking as Necessary

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution declaring the acquisition of Parcel 501 and of the four (4) year temporary construction easements (TCE) located at 3700 North River Drive needed for the construction of the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC)/Earlington Heights Connector, a 2.4 mile Metrorail corridor linking the MIC to the Earlington Heights Metrorail Station located at State Road (SR) 112 and NW 22 Avenue, to be for a public purpose, to be required and necessary to accomplish such construction; and authorizing the County Mayor or his designee and the County Attorney to take any and all appropriate actions to accomplish acquisition of the subject property in fee simple along with the four (4) year TCE, by Donation, purchase at values established by Appraisals or by Eminent Domain court proceedings including Declarations of Taking, as necessary.

Scope

Construction of MIC/Earlington Heights Connector is a critical component of the People's Transportation Plan (PTP). The entire length of the project is within Commission Districts 2, 3, and 6.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The right-of-way acquisition for the MIC/Earlington Heights Connector is funded through a combination of the \$100 million awarded by the State of Florida towards this project and proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Surtax. The MIC/Earlington Heights Connector is a priority corridor which is budgeted as part of the PTP.

Track Record/Monitor

Not Applicable

Background

The BCC approved Resolution R-825-06 on July 6, 2006, authorizing the acquisition of the right-of-way needed for construction of the MIC/Earlington Heights Connector, which included parcel 501 and TCE. Since passage of the above referenced resolution, it has been determined that a four (4) year TCE would be required to accomplish construction of the project.

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF PARCEL 501 AND FOUR (4) YEAR TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS (TCE) NEEDED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ORANGE LINE PHASE I: MIAMI INTERMODAL CENTER (MIC) – EARLINGTON HEIGHTS CONNECTOR PROJECT, A 2.4 MILE CORRIDOR LINKING THE MIC TO THE EARLINGTON HEIGHTS METRORAIL STATION LOCATED AT STATE ROAD (SR) 112 AND NW 22 AVENUE, TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO ACCOMPLISH ACQUISITION OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN FEE SIMPLE AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS BY DONATION, PURCHASE AT VALUES ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISALS OR BY EMINENT DOMAIN COURT PROCEEDINGS INCLUDING DECLARATIONS OF TAKING, AS NECESSARY

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds and declares the acquisition of the parcel of land in fee simple and temporary construction easements as legally described in “Exhibit A” and shown on the project location map in “Exhibit B” attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the public purpose of construction of the Orange Line Phase 1: Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) - Earlington Heights Connector project, to be required and necessary to accomplish such construction; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is authorized under the Constitution and Laws of Florida, including Chapters 73, 74, 125, 127 and 341, Florida Statutes, and Sections 1.01 (A) (1), (2) and (21), of the Home Rule Charter of Miami-Dade County, to acquire said property and easements including by eminent domain proceedings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes and directs the County Mayor or his designee and the County Attorney to take any and all appropriate actions to acquire the subject property in fee simple and temporary construction

easements, as legally described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, by donation, purchase, or by eminent domain proceedings, including declarations of taking, as necessary.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

The Chairperson thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 8th day of April, 2008. EXHIBIT "A"
LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Parcel No. 501: That portion of Lots 5 through 21, inclusive, and that certain parcel or piece of land designated as a "Public Park" lying Southerly of Northwest North River Drive, and Westerly of said Lot 21, all in Block 75, **MELROSE HEIGHTS 5TH. SECTION**, according to the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 17 at Page 22 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCE at the Northwest corner of said Block 75; thence run S 50°50'50" E, along the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive, for a distance of 111.14 feet, to a point of intersection with a non tangent circular curve concave to the Southeast from where the radius point bears S 82°45'38" E and the **POINT OF BEGINNING** of the parcel of land herein described; thence run Southwesterly along the said non tangent circular curve concave to the Southeast being also the Westerly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector, having a radius of 3239.83 feet through a central angle of 0°09'11" for an arc distance 8.65 feet to a point of tangency; thence run S 07°05'11" W, along the Westerly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector for a distance of 272.05 feet, more or less, to the Miami Canal; thence S 51°16'16" E, along the Miami Canal, for a distance of 48.16 feet, more or less, to the Easterly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector; thence run N 07°05'11" E, along the Easterly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector for a distance of 280.30 feet to the point of intersection with the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive; thence run N 50°50'50" W, along the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive, for a distance of 48.37 feet, to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, together with all the riparian rights appurtenant thereto.

Reserving a permanent easement for ingress and egress under the completed Metrorail guideway across the above described lands except within five (5) feet of the columns as physically located on the ground after construction.

That portion of Lots 5 through 21, inclusive, and that certain parcel or piece of land designated as a "Public Park" lying Southerly of Northwest North River Drive, and Westerly of said Lot 21, all in Block 75, **MELROSE HEIGHTS 5TH. SECTION**, according to the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 17 at Page 22 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of said Block 75; thence run S 50°50'50" E , along the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive, for a distance of 111.14 feet, to a point of intersection with a non tangent circular curve concave to the Southeast from where the radius point bears S 82°45'38" E ; thence run Southwesterly along the said non tangent circular curve concave to the Southeast being also the Westerly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector, having a radius of 3239.83 feet through a central angle of 0°09'11" for an arc distance 8.65 feet to a point of tangency; thence run S 07°05'11" W, along the Westerly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector for a distance of 175.52 feet, to a point; thence run N 82°54'49" W , perpendicular to the last described course, for a distance of 56.88 feet to a point of intersection with the West line of said Block 75; thence run N 01°37'48" W, along the West line of said Block 75, for a distance of 246.03 feet to the point of intersection with the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive being also the **POINT OF BEGINNING**,

Except that the owner shall have access for ingress and egress through the temporary construction easement area whenever the easement areas are not being used on the ground by the condemnor's contractors.

SECTION**, according to the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 17 at Page 22 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCE at the Northwest corner of said Block 75; thence run S 50°50'50" E, along the Southwesterly right of way line of Northwest North River Drive, for a distance of 159.51 feet, to a point of intersection with the Easterly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector; thence run S 07°05'11" W, along said Easterly right of way line, for a distance of 92.68 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING** of the parcel of land herein described; thence run S

82°54'49" E , perpendicular to the last described course, for a distance of 34.00 feet to a point; thence run S 07°05'11" W, along a line 34.00 feet Southeasterly of and parallel with the said Easterly right of way line, for a distance 208.06 feet, more or less, to the Miami Canal; thence N 51°16'16" W, along the Miami Canal, for a distance of 39.94 feet, more or less, to the Easterly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector; thence run N 07°05'11" E, along the Easterly right of way line of the Metrorail Extension MIC-Earlinton Heights Connector for a distance of 187.11 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, together with all the riparian rights appurtenant thereto,
