Subject: Resolution Authorizing Award of Competitive Contracts

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the attached award of competitive contracts, with authority to exercise options-to-renew and contract modifications. **Contract amounts and department allocations represent the maximum spending authority based on past utilization. This action does not guarantee that the total contract amount/value will be expended by County departments and/or agencies.**

Scope

The impact of the items in the accompanying Award of Competitive Contracts Package is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The accompanying Award of Competitive Contracts Package states the allocation amount and funding source for each department utilizing a contract. **Funding will be expended only if departmental budgets can support the expenditures approved in their Resource Allocation Plan adopted annually by the Board.**

Per Ordinance No. 02-116, the use of People's Transportation Plan (PTP) surtax funds requires Board approval, regardless of the dollar amount. The allocated PTP surtax funds will support expanded operations associated with the implementation of capital improvements, maintenance, and/or operations as described by the PTP legislation (Ordinance No. 02-116) and its amendments, including but not limited to Resolution No. R-1154-03 adopted on October 9, 2003, which added the Miscellaneous Capital Improvements Projects List and authorized significant infrastructure improvements for existing Miami-Dade Transit facilities.

Track Record/Monitor

There are no known performance issues with the vendors recommended for award in the accompanying Award of Competitive Contracts Package. Each department's contract manager is reflected in the accompanying Award of Competitive Contracts Package.

Delegated Authority

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or his designee will have the authority to exercise in his discretion subsequent options-to-renew, extend contracts and for purchase of goods

and services in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contracts listed in the accompanying Award of Competitive Contracts Package.

Background

Section 1 AWARD OF COMPETITIVE BIDS

The contracts listed in this section, are being recommended for award to the lowest priced, responsive, responsible bidder who met the bid specifications in accordance with established policies and procedures.

Item 1.1: Mobile Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Replacement Parts and Service, Pre-qualification of Vendors is to award this contract to establish a pool of pre-qualified vendors to purchase original mobile equipment manufacturer replacements parts and service, truck and major components equipment with repair or installation service, named brand replacement parts and service, and specialized heavy duty vehicle parts and service. The emergency bridge contract is being presented to the Board as **Item 3.1** in the Waiver of Formal Bid Procedures package. The amount being requested is **\$7,728,232**

Item 1.2: Passenger Loading Bridges, Pre-qualification of Vendors is to award this contract to establish a pool of pre-qualified vendors to provide and install passenger loading bridges for the Miami-Dade Aviation Department. The amount being requested is **\$4,000,000**.

Section 2 REJECTED BIDS

A bid may be rejected when adverse conditions exist such as the proposal not conforming to the specifications and/or solicitation documents, insufficient financial resources, technical ability, physical capacity and/or skill of the vendor, unfair and unreasonable pricing, insufficient competition and for any other cause in the best interest of the County.

Item 2.1: Functional Assessment for ADA Paratransit Eligibility is to reject all proposals received for paratransit eligibility evaluations for persons with physical, cognitive, sensory and other disabilities for Miami-Dade Transit.

Section 3 COMPETITIVE CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS

A competitive contract modification is an award of a supplemental allocation for goods or services within the scope of the original contract award.

Item 3.1: Automotive Truck Parts and Accessories is for additional time and spending authority to allow various County departments to purchase non-dealer and aftermarket automotive truck parts. The additional amount being requested is **\$2,609,065**.

Item 3.2: Process, Control and Instrumentation, Pre-qualifications of Vendors is for additional spending authority to allow the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department to continue to purchase maintain, inspect and repair process, control and instrumentation equipment. The additional amount being requested is **\$380,000**.

Item 3.3: Transit Vehicle Parts and Repair Services, Pre-qualification of Vendors is for additional time and spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) to purchase parts and repair services for buses and support equipment. In addition, to authorize the use of People's Transportation Plan surtax funds for MDT's allocation. The additional amount being requested is **\$12,000,000**.

Item 3.4: Tire Leasing and Vehicle Tire Services is for additional spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) to continue to lease tires and provide related tire services to for buses. In addition, to authorize the use of People's Transportation Plan surtax funds for MDT's allocation. The additional amount being requested is **\$6,600,000**.

Item 3.5: Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Parts and Repair for Metrorail and Metromover Vehicles is for additional spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) to purchase genuine original equipment manufacturer parts and repair for Metrorail and Metromover vehicles. In addition, to authorize the use of People's Transportation Plan surtax funds for MDT's allocation. The additional amount being requested is **\$9,500,000**.

Section 4 PURCHASES MADE UNDER COMPETITIVELY AWARDED CONTRACTS OF OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES

The County occasionally accesses contracts competed and awarded by federal, state and local governments, and by not-for-profit organizations, when it is legally permissible and, it is determined to be in the best interest of the County, and the item is not available through an existing County contract.

Item 4.1: Information Technology (IT) Hardware is to approve access to a competitively established contract by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools for purchase of information technology hardware for the Enterprise Technology Services Department and other County departments. The amount being requested is **\$20,817,007**.

Section 5 APPROVAL OF THE USE OF PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN SURTAX FUNDS

Per Ordinance No. 02-116, the use of People's Transportation Plan (PTP) surtax funds requires Board approval, regardless of the dollar amount. The allocated PTP surtax funds will support expanded operations associated with the implementation of capital improvements, maintenance, and/or operations as described by the PTP legislation (Ordinance No. 02-116) and its amendments, including but not limited to Resolution No. R-1154-03 adopted on October 9, 2003, which added the Miscellaneous Capital Improvements Projects List and authorized significant infrastructure improvements for existing Miami-Dade Transit facilities.

Item 5.1: Bus Stop Signs and Components, Pre-qualification of Vendors is to award a contract for Miami-Dade Transit to purchase bus stop signage and components. The amount being requested is **\$500,000**.

Item 5.2: Maintenance of Fire Extinguishers and Fire Hoses is to approve an allocation for Miami-Dade Transit for maintenance of fire extinguishers and fire hoses. The amount being requested is **\$3,940**.

Item 5.3: Oil/Water Separation Equipment and Water Drainage Filtration System, Maintenance and Repair is to approve an allocation for Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) to purchase oil/water separation equipment and drainage filtration system, maintenance and repair services. The approval of an emergency bridge contract for MDT is being presented to the Board as **Item 6.1** in the Bid Waiver package on this agenda. The amount being requested is **\$350,000**.

Item 5.4: Bus Washing Chemicals is for additional spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit to continue to purchase bus washing chemicals. The additional amount being requested is **\$400,000**.

Item 5.5: Petroleum Products, Pre-qualification of Vendors is for additional spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit to purchase various petroleum products. The additional amount being requested is **\$130,000**.

Item 5.6: Household Commercial and Industrial Appliances and Accessories is for additional spending authority to allow Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) to access the Broward County School Board contract to purchase refrigerator/freezers, tabletop microwave ovens and self-contained icemakers for MDT employee break rooms. The additional amount being requested is **\$55,500**.

Item 5.7: Title and Closing Services, Pre-qualification of Vendors is to award an allocation for the Public Works Department for title and closing services. The amount being requested is **\$400,000**.

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners award the referenced contract to the vendors listed below, to provide mobile equipment manufacturer (OEM) replacement parts and service for various County departments.

TITLE: Mobile Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Replacements Parts and Service

DESCRIPTION: To establish a contract for the purchase of original mobile equipment manufacturer (OEM) replacement parts and service, truck and major components equipment with repair or installation service, named brand replacement parts and service, and specialized heavy-duty vehicle parts and service.

APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE: June 26, 2007

TERM: One-year, with six one-year options-to-renew

ALLOCATION:** \$15,344,752 for a twenty-five month period

The emergency bridge contract is being presented to the Board as **Item 3.1** in the Waiver of Formal Bid Procedures package.

METHOD OF AWARD: Up to three bidders per line item, who offer the highest percentage discount for parts from Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price List (MSRP), and up to three lowest bidders per Manufacturer's line item who offer the lowest labor rate within each group. Bidders may offer pricing for parts only or for labor and parts.

FOR PARTS ONLY

Award of parts by manufacturer will be made to the three responsive, responsible bidders who offer the highest discount from Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price List (MSRP), which represents the lowest cost to the County on an item-by-item basis within each group.

LABOR & PARTS

Award of labor and parts by manufacturer will be made to up to three lowest responsive, responsible bidders who offered the lowest Labor Rate per hour and percentage discount for parts when added in the aggregate on an item-by-item basis within each group. To compute the labor rate the bidder will specify their current posted shop labor rate and the discount offered to the County from that labor rate. The discount percentage offered will remain fixed for the entire term, including any options to renew which the County may exercise.

While the award will be made to multiple bidders by item to assure availability, the first opportunity to perform will be given to the bidder whose pricing is expected to result in the lowest total price to the County for the work required (i.e.; parts only, components and labor or a labor intensive installation which cost of labor exceeds the cost of parts). The County reserves the right to consider geographic location in its determination of lowest expected cost, when orders are placed by County Departments.

Manufacturer lines not awarded for parts and labor may be awarded by the County after the contract is established. Manufacturer's certified dealers and all manufacturers' certified re-sellers, may compete to join the contract by completion and submittal of the following:

- a) Compliance with the requirements of Section 1 Paragraph 1.2 (Vendor Registration & Affidavits).
- b) Section 4 of this solicitation.
- c) One copy of the manufacturer's published price list for each item offered.
- d) One copy of your manufacturer's dealer or reseller's certification.

Manufacturers not awarded parts and labor, offers must be equal to, or greater than, the average percentage discounts for manufacturer line parts offered to the County at bid opening and the average percentage discounts from labor rates offered to the County at bid opening.

The bidder must hold a Manufacturer's Original Equipment (OEM) parts or parts and service dealership agreement, distributorship agreement, or hold a manufacturer's OEM approved reseller agreement for the brand bid, or service type offered, for Groups A, B and C. A copy of the OEM parts dealership, distributorship or approved seller agreement shall be submitted with the bid proposal, or no later than the conclusion of the bid evaluation period. Group A is Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Replacement Parts & Services, Group B is Truck and Major Component OEM Equipment & OEM Parts by Brand and Labor Service, and Group C is Replacement Parts and Service for the Listed Brands.


The estimated value of this contract is \$7,728,232 for one-year period. The allocation for the new contract is based on the estimated quantities of the line items awarded.

Bid announcements were sent to 609 vendors; both electronically and by mail, and a total of 109 vendors downloaded the solicitation. Bids were received from fifty-four (54) vendors. As a result of the BAFO, 10 line items remained unchanged, on six line items non-local vendors remained the lowest bidders, and 13 line items were awarded to local vendors.

The SBE Preference was applied in accordance with the ordinance, but it did not affect the award.

BACKGROUND

Paratransit eligibility evaluations as mentioned above, and sought through this solicitation, are currently being performed in-house by MDT personnel, and documented by medical evaluations provided by the applicant.

This solicitation was issued as a Request for Proposals under full and open competition on July 9, 2007. One proposal was received on September 7, 2007 from ADARIDE.COM. Market research was conducted and revealed that prices from the sole proposer were higher for comparative services. Further, evaluation services in the market are currently conducted through in-person assessments in order to provide a thorough physical, cognitive and sensory evaluation.

Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) desires an in-person assessment team to perform eligibility assessment services. However, the sole proposal from ADARIDE.COM included a web-based component as part of its functional assessment model. MDT believes that the online component would limit access to the full assessment services needed. This approach would likely create a hardship for seniors and disabled persons in Miami-Dade County. The web-based component is not consistent with MDT's goal of making the in-person functional assessment the key determining factor for Special Transportation Services eligibility, or the practice of issuing picture identification to MDT passengers.

The County is exploring options for providing eligibility services. The County may be able to access a contract being used by another governmental agency. On November 15, 2007 the South Florida Water Management District approved a 20-year Consumptive Use Permit. The permit authorizes WASD to continue drawing 347 million gallons per day from the Biscayne Aquifer from the 98 production wells owned and operated by the department. To remain in compliance with the permit, new sensing flow meters are required on many of the production wells. These flow meters allow for real time accounting of water drawn from the Biscayne Aquifer, and will assist the County in planning to meet the future needs and water demands of the expanding South Florida region. The department's average expenditures on this contract are \$117,000 per month. To accommodate the current and future requirements of the water and wastewater treatment plants, the additional allocation will allow sufficient funding for the duration of the contract term.

The department has an approved multi-year capital improvement plan in place to upgrade the entire water and sewer infrastructure.
