**Subject:** Resolution Authorizing the Award of FY 2007-08 Community-based Organization  
Round 2 and 3 District Responsive Grants

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the award for the FY 2007-08 Community-based Organizations (CBO) Round 2 and 3 District Responsive Grants and corrections to previously approved allocations. Funding for these grants is provided through the reallocation of previously appropriated funding.

## **SCOPE**

The impact of this resolution is countywide.

## **FISCAL IMPACT / FUNDING SOURCE**

Funding for these grants is being provided through the reallocation of previously approved funding.

## **BACKGROUND**

Certain District Responsive Grants Rounds 2 and 3 were not included as part of the FY 2007-08 Continuation Funding for CBOs. These particular grants were not forwarded by the Alliance for Human Services in time to incorporate as part of the final funding recommendations for CBOs. A line item was included in the allocated funding – "Alliance for Human Services, Various allocation to be determined including unallocated district responsive grants" – in anticipation of these allocations being submitted to the Board for approval. In addition, certain organizations have declined previously approved grant awards. Also, it is necessary to correct scrivener's errors included in the previously approved list. The attached table details these allocations.

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum and the attached table of corrected allocations, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community-based Organization funding for Round 2 and Round 3 District Responsive grants were not included as part of the FY 2007-08 funding recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, additional adjustments are to be made to the FY 2007-08 funding allocations due to organizations declining previously approved allocations and to correct scrivener's errors; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for said allocations is to be provided through the reallocation of recaptured funding,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board authorizes approval of FY 2007-08 Community-based Organization Round 2 and Round 3 District Responsive grants and funding adjustments to previously approved allocations delineated in the attached schedule; and authorizes the Mayor or designee to execute
