


PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed work in this project shall take place in an area east of Chapman Field Park (located at the terminus of SW 124th Street and Old Cutler Road, in the City of Coral Gables). The objective is to restore and enhance approximately eleven (11) acres of mangrove habitat through the removal of solid waste, trash, and fill material from two separate sites located along the south end of the access road.

EXPLANATION: The Contract is being awarded for the budgeted and approved amount in accordance with the Request to Advertise approved by the Board on 09/04/07. The bid submitted by WRS Infrastructure & Environment, Inc. includes a base bid of \$1,019,472.85, an option for remaining areas site 2 of \$859,292.06 and an option for site 1 of \$207,714.66. All bid amounts include 10% contingency. This is based on quantities stated in the bid forms of the document and are used as a determination of the lowest bidder and to establish competitive unit prices for this project. This is a unit price contract and the scope of work remains unchanged. Any remaining contract capacity will be used for additional work within the projects limits until the total expenditure of funds, or up to the Contract's expiration date, whichever comes first. DERM staff prepared estimates for the base bid and both optional items. The base bid estimate was reduced prior to the bid date to evaluate the project's feasibility (area cleared and excavated) despite rising fuel costs which will affect hauling costs. At this time, DERM has enough funding to authorize the contractor to complete the base bid and option number 2 for a total of \$1,115,625.01. A ten percent (10%) contingency will be applied (\$111,562.50). The total amount will be \$1,227,187.51. A review of the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) indicated that WRS has completed one project with DERM (C02-DERM-EEC 23). No evaluations were found.

Background

BACKGROUND:

When the project was first advertised on 11/29/05, an error was discovered in the Engineer's cost estimate. Consequently, the Department was required to terminate the bidding process, and the Engineer of Record submitted revised estimates to DERM on 10/26/2006 with an amount of \$1,283,750.00. Subsequently, the project was resubmitted to the Department of Business Development as Project Number 200512457-R with no changes to goals or the scope of work. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) provided a significant amount of funding for this restoration work. To comply with Federal Acquisition Regulations, Davis-Bacon wage rates shall be utilized for this project. Resolution No. R-475-05 approved on 3/1/05 and amended twice, the first 12/01/06 and secondly on 6/08/07, authorizes expenditures up to \$468,750.00. Resolution No. R-288-05, approved 05/03/05, authorizes expenditures up to \$580,000.00. The third funding source will come for the Biscayne Bay Environmental Trust Fund (Biscayne Bay Restoration and Shoreline Stabilization) authorizing a funding amount of up to \$235,000.00 for this project.




