ADA Paratransit Eligibility

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the rejection of the sole proposal received for the referenced solicitation to provide evaluation services and paratransit eligibility evaluations for persons with physical, cognitive, sensory and other disabilities, to determine if they are functionally able to use the fixed-route bus system, either permanently, temporarily or under certain conditions pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

CONTRACT NO: RFP 8410-3/14

CONTRACT TITLE: Functional Assessment for ADA Paratransit Eligibility

DESCRIPTION: ADA paratransit eligibility evaluations for persons with disabilities.

PROJECT MANAGER: Rita Kane, Miami-Dade Transit

APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE: July 9, 2007

TERM: Three years with three, one year options-to-renew

CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$10,000,000 for the initial three year term

FUNDING SOURCE: Operating revenue and PTP

METHOD OF AWARD: To the highest ranked proposer

VENDORS RECOMMENDED FOR AWARD: None – recommendation is to reject all proposals.

CONTRACT MEASURES: The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) selection factor applies to this RFP.

LIVING WAGE: The services being provided are not covered under the Living Wage Ordinance.

USER ACCESS PROGRAM: This Request for Proposals includes the User Access Program provision. The 2% program discount will be collected on all purchases.

LOCAL PREFERENCE: Applied in accordance with the Ordinance.

ESTIMATED CONTRACT COMMENCEMENT DATE: Not Applicable

BACKGROUND

Paratransit eligibility evaluations as mentioned above, and sought through this solicitation, are currently being performed in-house by MDT personnel, and documented by medical evaluations provided by the applicant.

This solicitation was issued as a Request for Proposals under full and open competition on July 9, 2007. One proposal was received on September 7, 2007 from ADARIDE.COM. Market research was conducted and revealed that prices from the sole proposer were higher for comparative services. Further, evaluation services in the market are currently conducted through in-person assessments in order to provide a thorough physical, cognitive and sensory evaluation.

Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) desires an in-person assessment team to perform eligibility assessment services. However, the sole proposal from ADARIDE.COM included a web-based component as part of its functional assessment model. MDT believes that the online component would limit access to the full assessment services needed. This approach would likely create a hardship for seniors and disabled persons in Miami-Dade County. The web-based component is not consistent with MDT's goal of making the in-person functional assessment the key determining factor for Special Transportation Services eligibility, or the practice of issuing picture identification to MDT passengers.

The County is exploring options for providing eligibility services. The County may be able to access a contract being used by another governmental agency. The Department of Procurement Management is reviewing the contract used by Broward County and the Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority, while working with Transit to develop requirements that may be used if a new solicitation is needed.
