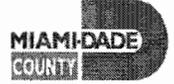

**Subject:** Contract Award Recommendation for the Installation of approximately 4,600 Linear Feet of 10" and 12" Force Main from Pump Station No. 427 to the 16" Force Main at Intersection of NW 191st Street and NW 37th Avenue - Contract No: S-827 to Metro Equipment Service, Inc. - in the amount of \$880,297.80

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners award Contract No. S-827 to Metro Equipment Service, Inc. in the amount of \$880,297.80 for the installation of force main from Pump Station (PS) No. 427 to the intersection of NW 191st Street and NW 37th Avenue for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD). PS No. 427 is under a conditional moratorium imposed by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). The USEPA will lift this moratorium if the discharge capacity of the pump station is increased, requiring a new force main to carry the increased flow.

## DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The authority of the County Mayor or his designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The project consists of constructing a 10-inch and 12-inch diameter sanitary sewer force main from Pump Station No. 427, located at 2790 NW 191 Street, to a 16-inch force main located at the intersection of NW 191 Street and NW 37 Avenue.

The project includes, but it is not limited to furnishing and installing the following: approximately 2,500 linear feet of 12-inch, 2,000 linear feet of 10-inch, and 120 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron pipe and fittings; 8, 10 and 12-inch valves, and automatic air release valve assemblies; cleaning and testing the main; traffic control; temporary and permanent paving repairs; replacing pavement markings; constructing concrete sidewalk; restoration of sodded areas, and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items and work for a complete installation.

It is the intent of the Department to obtain a complete functional, and

satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The Contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.

**EXPLANATION:** WASD received 10 bids for this project. Nine of the bidders were under the engineer's base estimate. The low apparent bidder was found non-responsive because the company did not comply with the Department of Small Business Development's make-up requirement of \$655,000 for other County contracts.

The recommended contractor, Metro Equipment Service, Inc., is the second

lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, and was 30 percent under the engineer's base estimate. The difference between the base estimate and base contract amount is due to Metro bidding under WASD's estimate for bid item nos. 5, 22, 24, 28 and 31. WASD's estimates were based on past projects of similar size, scope and complexity, as well as the construction market conditions of one year ago. The Engineer of Record has performed a bid analysis and finds the contract amount to be appropriate.

Enterprise Make-up Requirements

This memorandum serves as a follow-up to the December 6, 2007 memorandum concerning Metro Equipment Services, Inc.'s (Metro) compliance with Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) make-up requirements. Metro has a CSBE make-up requirement of \$626,550 on its record. It had approved CSBE make-up plans on two (2) previously awarded projects. Specifically, \$259,995.97 was going to be made-up on S-769 and \$7,440 on S-742. On September 11, 2007, Metro submitted a request to revise its CSBE make-up plan to meet the entire \$626,550 make-up solely on Water and Sewer Department (WASD) Project No. S-769.

Project No. S-769 was awarded as a two-year contract with two additional one-year options to renew. WASD exercised the first one-year option which expires in March 2008. The current contract amount is \$9,750,000. The project was awarded with a 13.50% CSBE goal which currently equals \$1,316,250. CSBE participation by March 2008 inclusive of the make-up plan should equal \$1,942,800. Through December 25, 2007, Metro reported payments to its CSBE certified firms of \$2,076,754.

WASD has indicated it plans to exercise the second one-year option to renew increasing the contract value to \$13,263,250 resulting in increased CSBE participation inclusive of the make-up to \$2,417,088. Please note full compliance with the CSBE goal and make-up on this project cannot be determined until the project is completed and final dollars authorized/paid to Metro and the CSBE subcontractors are reported. The second one-year option will extend the contract through March 2009.

Per your request, please find herein below the bid justification for the subject project (Contract S-827). This review only applies to the Bid Items that were identified in your enclosed email below.

**Bid Item 5:** MDWASD estimated it at \$53/LF compared with \$20/LF by the Low Bidder. The MDWASD cost was based on historical analysis of past bids for projects of similar size, scope and complexity. This approach has consistently been used in our pipeline estimation process for several years and with success. This is one of the few cases where there is an apparent disparity in costs. Additionally, based on the ten bids received for this solicitation, the average cost is about \$59/LF. In our opinion, our cost represents the range typically used in the industry for this particular procurement.

**Bid Item 22:** MDWASD estimated it at \$15/LF compared with \$1/LF by the Low Bidder. Our estimate considered the geotechnical soil investigation report for the area that indicated very poor soil conditions where the pipe is to be laid. The proposed protection on both sides of the pipe trench is for approximately one-half of a mile of cuts on unstable soil, and with the pipe being laid under water. Factoring all these into the range of unit costs obtained from previous bid tabulations for this type of work, we believe our cost is more realistic than the \$1/LF that the contractor is quoting.

**Bid Item 24:** MDWASD estimate is 10% of the sub-total cost of all construction activities compared with the contractor's quote of about 9%. Our cost was based on historical analysis of past bids for projects of similar size, scope and complexity, and considering current traffic pattern in the project area. Based on field visits during the design phase, maintenance of traffic (MOT) plans developed for the project area with an elementary school and church, considering the additional requirements for pipe stringing and staging of work within the right-of-way, and the need to procure and maintain law-enforcement presence during construction, it is our opinion that the percentage allocation of costs utilized is realistic.

**Bid Item 28:** MDWASD estimate is 10% of the sub-total cost for Mobilization and Demobilization compared with the contractor's quote of about 7% of its bid amount. Our cost was based on historical analysis of past bids for projects of similar size, scope and complexity, and considering the additional need for pipe stringing and staging of work in a residential area with a school (Brentwood Elementary) and church.

**Bid Item 31:** Both the Low Bidder (Metro Equipment) and MDWASD estimated this item based on 10% of the sub-total cost. Historically, the Department have always adopted a 10% cost allocation of the sub-total cost of all construction activities for Unforeseen Conditions for minor construction changes and for quantity adjustments, as ordered by the Engineer (MDWASD). Thus, since MDWASD costs are somewhat higher, logically our estimated 10% cost will be higher than the contractor's quote.

In summary, considering the above explanations, and the additional itemized cost differences shown in the spreadsheet document previously prepared and forwarded by the Design Project Manager, Alex Retamar, it is our opinion that our estimate of probable cost for the project is within industry cost range. Please note that we are unable to establish if there is a case of front-loading in this particular bid. It is our opinion that it is in the best interest of the County to proceed with the project as bid.

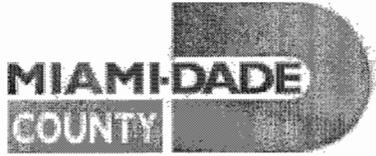

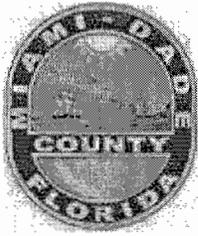

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# CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Miami-Dade County, Florida, party of the first part (hereinafter sometimes called the "County"), and **Metro Equipment Service, Inc.**, party of the second part (hereinafter sometimes called "Contractor");

## WITNESSETH

That the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, mutually agree as follows, to wit:

1. That the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and equipment and perform all work in the manner and form provided by the Contract Documents covering the Project of the County known and identified as

**“Installation of Approx. 4600 L.F. of 10” and 12” F.M. from P.S. 427  
to the 16” F.M. at Intersection of NW 191 St. and NW 37 Ave.,  
Contract No. S-827”**

for the aggregate amount reflected by the Proposal, said aggregate amount being of **Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars and Eighty Cents (U.S. Dollars) \$880,297.80.**

2. That the Contractor shall begin the work to be performed under this Contract on a day to be specified in a written order issued by the Engineer, and shall fully complete all work hereunder within the time or times stated in the Proposal.

3. That the County shall pay to the Contractor for the faithful performance of this Contract, in lawful money of the United States, and subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents, the total amount of his proposal as set forth above at the times and in a manner stated in the General Covenants and Conditions of the Contract Documents.

4. It is further mutually agreed that if at any time after the execution of this Contract, Surety Performance and Payment Bond, the County shall deem the surety upon such bonds to be unsatisfactory, or if for any reason such bond shall become inadequate to cover the performance of the work, the Contractor shall at his own expense, within five (5) days after the receipt of notice from the County to do so, furnish an additional bond or bonds in such form and amount and with such surety or sureties as shall be satisfactory to the County. In such event, no further payment to the Contractor shall be deemed to be due under this Contract until such new or additional security shall have been furnished in a manner and form satisfactory to the County.

5. The "Contract Documents" are hereby defined as the Questionnaire, the Advertisement for Bids, the Instructions to Bidders, the Proposal, the Certified Resolution (Proposal/Prescribed Bid Bond), the Prescribed Bid Bond, the Contract, the Surety Performance and Payment Bond, the Certified Resolution (Contract/ Surety Performance and Payment Bond), the General Covenants and Conditions, the Supplemental General Conditions (if Ordinance 90-143 is applicable) including Wage and Benefit Schedules, the Specifications, the Plans, any Addenda which may be issued, the Subcontractor /Supplier Listing Form (Ordinance 97-104 as amended by Ordinance 00-30), the Reporting Subcontracting Policies and Procedures (Ordinance 98 -15 9), the Community Small Business Enterprise Program (CSBE) Participation Provisions and Forms (if applicable), and the provisions for the following: Affirmative Action Plan (Ordinance 98-30) and Disclosure Form; Bidder's (Debarment) (Ordinance 93-129); Code of Business Ethics (Ordinance 01-96); Criminal Record (Felony) (as amended by Ordinance 00-30); Disability Nondiscrimination (Resolution R - 3 8 5 -95 as amended by Resolution R-182-00); Domestic Violence Leave (Ordinance 99 - 5 as amended by Resolution R-185-00); Due Fees or Taxes Paid (Ordinance 95-178 as amended by Ordinance 00-30); Metro-Dade Employment Drug-Free Workplace (Ordinance 92-15 as amended by Ordinance 00-30); Metro-Dade Employment Family Leave Plan (Ordinance 91-142 as amended by Resolution R-183-00); Fair Wage (Ordinance 90-143 as amended by Ordinance 95-183); Mandatory Clearinghouse for Posting Notice of Job Opportunities (Resolution R-937-98 as

The terms and conditions of said Contract Documents are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein. The Contract Documents are complementary, so that a recital in one is tantamount to a recital in all, and the Contractor specifically acknowledges that he has read and understands all of said Contract Documents.

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Small Business Development (SBD) has completed a compliance review for the above-referenced project with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program. The contract measure applicable to this project is a three percent (3%) CSBE subcontractor goal. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) submitted bid documents from Development and Communication Group of Florida for compliance review. SBD issued a compliance determination on August 14, 2007 deeming Development and Communication Group of Florida in compliance with the CSBE program requirements. Subsequently, WASD submitted bid documents from Metro Equipment Service, Inc. and requested a compliance determination be completed.
