RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO INCLUDE, IN MEMORANDA TO THE
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RELATING TO
COUNTY CONTRACTS, BOTH THE PERCENTAGE AND
THE DOLLAR VALUE OF THE SMALL BUSINESS GOAL
IMPOSED AND ACHIEVED

WHEREAS, the County has enacted various ordinances to promote the development of small businesses, including but not limited to Community Small Business Enterprises, Community Business Enterprises, and Small Business Enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the County contracts often require that a percentage of such contract be fulfilled by small businesses; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the Board of County Commissioners be able to determine when the contractors have met their small business goals,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or his designee is directed to include, in all memoranda to the Board of County Commissioners relating to County contracts which include a small business goal imposed pursuant to any County program, or imposed pursuant to any federal program administered by the County, information expressing the small business goal on the contract as both a percentage and as an actual dollar amount.

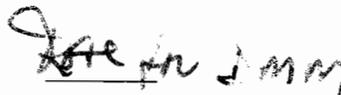
