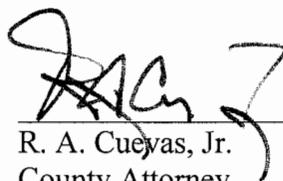

RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO INVESTIGATE THE POSSIBILITY AND COST OF PLACING SIGNAGE ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER, TO IDENTIFY AS THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING AND PROVIDE GREATER VISIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC

**WHEREAS**, the chambers of the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners, located in the Stephen P. Clark Center (“SPCC”) in downtown Miami, constitute the place where public hearings are held and the official business of the Board is conducted; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the chambers, individual offices of the members of the Board are located in the SPCC, where the members of the Board meet with their constituents and others who have a right to petition elected representatives; and

**WHEREAS**, other official County boards also conduct official business at the SPCC, where residents and others may approach and be heard; and

**WHEREAS**, numerous Miami-Dade County residents and visitors to the South Florida area must on occasion visit the SPCC to conduct business in the County’s central administration building; and

**WHEREAS**, the downtown Miami area can be difficult to navigate for those who do not travel frequently to the SPCC, yet should be provided convenient access; and

**WHEREAS**, better signage on the exterior of the SPCC, possibly similar to signage placed near the top of other large downtown office buildings, would aid members of the public seeking to locate the SPCC; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to comply with all applicable requirements of County and City of Miami regulations governing the placement of outdoor signage, providing the County no advantage or right beyond that already available to other similar buildings in the downtown Miami area,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board directs the Mayor or his designee to investigate the possibility of placing clearly visible signage on the SPCC to identify it as the Miami-Dade County central administration building and provide greater visibility to the traveling public, possibly similar to signage placed near the top of similar large downtown office buildings; to consult with appropriate municipal officials regarding the regulations governing such signage; and within 60 days to provide this Board a report on the manner and cost of signage that may be placed on the SPCC to achieve the purposes described herein.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Vice-Chairwoman Barbara J. Jordan and offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
