

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION DEPARTMENT, MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT AGENCY AND MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE MAY 2, 2008 "SAFETY AND CAREER DAY" SPONSORED BY THE BILLY RAVEN FOUNDATION, INC. A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$23,479.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Billy Raven Foundation, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department, Miami-Dade County Corrections and Rehabilitation Department, Miami-Dade Transit Agency and Miami-Dade Police Department for the May 2, 2008 "Safety and Career Day" event in an amount not to exceed \$23,479.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the "Safety and Career Day" event is to provide job recruitment opportunities to high school and college students upon graduation in the field of law enforcement and various other positions throughout Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Billy Raven Foundation, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "Safety and Career Day" event is a major event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$23,479.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department, Miami-Dade

County Corrections and Rehabilitation Department, Miami-Dade Transit Agency and Miami-Dade Police Department for the May 2, 2008 "Safety and Career Day" event in an amount not to exceed \$23,479.00 to be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund.

Subject: Countywide In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Billy Raven Foundation held on May 2, 2008 for their Safety and Career Day event.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$3,536 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for 4 sets of bleachers, \$4,158 from the Miami-Dade County Corrections and Rehabilitation Department for 2 corporals, 6 honor guards, 3 recruiters, and 6 cadets, \$495 from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for one command bus, and \$15,290 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for 1 Sergeant and 7 Officers, for a total in-kind amount of \$23,479. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2007-08, the Billy Raven Foundation has not received any County funding for this event.
