

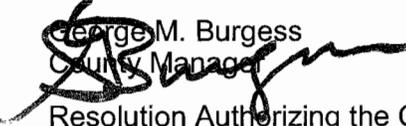

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution authorizing the conveyance of an easement to Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) for the installation of underground electric transmission and distribution lines to service Jackson South Community Hospital ("Jackson South").

BACKGROUND: On May 27, 2008, the Board of Trustees of the Public Health Trust approved Resolution No. PHT 05/08-036, authorizing the negotiation for relocation of an easement in favor of Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"). A copy of Resolution No. PHT 05/08-036 is attached and incorporated herein. FPL currently provides utility services by means of an easement on the western boundary of the Jackson South property. Jackson South

Community Hospital is being expanded and renovated and the expansion and renovation work would require construction on such easement therefore the existing FPL easement must be abandoned and replaced with a new utility easement in favor of FPL.

FACILITY

DESCRIPTION:

Jackson South is a 199-bed full service acute care hospital that generally operates at full or above capacity. Expansion of Jackson South has been approved by the Board of Trustees and the General Plan for the Expansion and Renovation of Jackson South was approved by the Commission on September 18, 2007 by Resolution No. R-1022-07. The plan for expansion and renovation includes approximately 180,000 square feet of new construction and 72,000 square feet of renovated space that will improve services provided by the Intensive Care, Surgery, Emergency, Diagnostic Imaging, Pharmacy, Admissions, Psychiatric Services, Observation Beds, Lab, Dietary, Materials Management and Miscellaneous Support Services Units. This facility is part of the countywide network of care that comprises the Jackson Health System.

JUSTIFICATION:

Because construction for the expansion and renovation project will impair the current FPL easement which serves Jackson South, FPL has requested an easement to construct, maintain and operate the underground electrical lines that will continue to provide electrical services to Jackson South through an easement relocated from its current location.

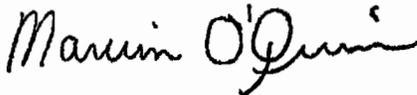

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF AN EASEMENT TO FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY (FPL) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION LINES, LOCATED AT JACKSON SOUTH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

REQUEST

Staff requests authorization for the President or his designee to negotiate the relocation of an easement in favor of Florida Power & Light Company for the provision of electrical services to Jackson South Community Hospital and to negotiate such other easements necessary or required for the provision of utility services to Jackson South and authorizing the President to seek Board of County Commissioners' approval of such easements and execution thereof. (Funding: Funding from General Obligation & JMH Revenue Bonds).

BACKGROUND

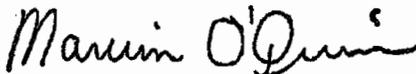
In July 2001, the Public Health Trust purchased the former Deering Hospital located at 9333 S.W. 152nd Street, Miami, Florida and renamed it " Jackson South Community Hospital."

In 2003, the Board of Trustees of the Public Health Trust approved the expansion and renovation of Jackson South Community Hospital. On August 23, 2005, the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution No. R-907-05 Resolution authorizing the execution of a contract for sale and purchase between Robert J, Shelley IV and Douglas F. Landsea, as sellers, and Miami-Dade County, as buyer, for four (4) million dollars for approximately 5.673 acres of vacant land located on the north side of 152 street, east of 95th avenue, Miami, Florida and adjacent to Jackson South Community Hospital to allow for facility expansion by the Public Health Trust; authorizing the County Manager to execute the contract for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County; and authorizing the County Manager to exercise any and all rights conferred therein.

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") currently provides utility services by means of an easement on the western boundary of the Jackson South property. The renovation work would require construction on such easement therefore the existing FPL easement must be abandoned and replaced with a new utility easement in favor of FPL. In addition, other utility easements may be impacted by the renovations, thus, the President seeks the additional authority to negotiate the relocation of those easement so that the President can seek the Board of County Commissioners without having to come again before the Board of Trustees.

RECOMMENDATION

I concur with Staff's recommendation to authorize the President or his designee to negotiate the relocation of an easement in favor of Florida Power & Light Company for the provision of electrical services to Jackson South Community Hospital and to negotiate such other easements necessary or required for the provision of utility services to Jackson South and authorizing the President to seek Board of County Commissioners' approval of such easements and execution thereof. (Funding: Funding from General Obligation & JMH Revenue Bonds).

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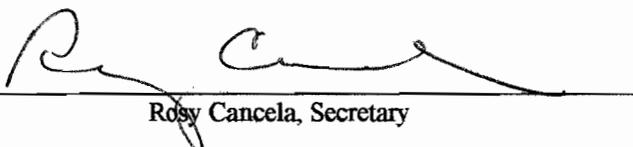

The undersigned, in consideration of the payment of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, grant and give to Florida Power & Light Company, its licensees, agents, successors, and assigns, an easement forever for the construction, operation and maintenance of overhead and underground electric utility facilities (including wires, poles, guys, cables, conduits and appurtenant equipment) to be installed from time to time; with the right to reconstruct, improve, add to, enlarge, change the voltage, as well as, the size of and remove such facilities or any of them within an easement ranging from 10 to 25 feet in width described as follows:

Reserved for Circuit Court

SEE EXHIBIT "A" FOR LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND SKETCH

Together with the right to permit any other person, firm or corporation to attach wires to any facilities hereunder and lay cable and conduit within the easement and to operate the same for communications purposes; the right of ingress and egress to said premises at all times; the right to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth and other obstructions within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution; and further grants, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, the rights hereinabove granted on the land heretofore described, over, along, under and across the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.
