

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND IMPLEMENT AN EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN DIRECTED TO "BIG BOX" RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS TO INFORM SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS OF POTENTIAL FINES AND VIOLATIONS RESULTING FROM THEIR FAILURE TO CLEAN AND MAINTAIN THEIR PROPERTIES ON A REGULAR BASIS

WHEREAS, the number of large "big box" retail establishments located throughout Miami-Dade County has significantly increased; and

WHEREAS, failure on the part of these "big box" retailers to properly clean and maintain their properties may result in extensive litter, dirt, blight or unsightly mess, thereby creating an unsightly condition which disrupts the neighborhoods in which these retailers are located; and

WHEREAS, education of these "big box" retailers regarding potential penalties and fines which may be imposed for failure to maintain their properties may reduce the incidents of the unsightly conditions described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or his designee is directed to prepare and implement an educational campaign directed to all large "big box" retail establishments to remind these retailers of their responsibility to ensure that their properties are properly cleaned and maintained so as to be free of litter, overgrowth or an accumulation of junk and trash. Said program shall include education concerning potential penalties and fines which may be imposed for failure to maintain their properties.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss.
