## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve this contract award recommendation to H&R Paving, Inc. (H&R) in the amount of \$10,025,000 and authorize the Mayor or his designee to execute the contract, a summary of which is attached hereto. The full contract is on file with the Clerk's office.

## **Scope**

The impact of this agenda item is countywide in nature as it relates to the total Miami-Dade Aviation System.

## **Delegated Authority**

In accordance with Section 2-8.3 relating to delegation of Board authority, the Mayor or designee has the authority to exercise the option to extend and terminate the agreement.

## **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The amount of the contract is \$7,525,000 for the initial term of the contract of 730 calendar days and includes the Inspector General fee. The contract also provides two (2) one-year options to renew at \$1,250,000 each, for a total contract amount of \$10,025,000. The work under this contract will be issued on a task order basis and the Contractor will be paid based on the fully burdened Unit Prices on their Bid Form. This contract will be funded from MDAD operational funds.

## **Track Record/Monitor**

H&R serves as the current firm for the Pavement Repairs Contract for the Miami-Dade Aviation Department (MDAD). Under that contract, the track record for H&R has been satisfactory according to Project Manager Joaquin Menendez, of MDAD Civil Environmental Engineering, who monitors the pavement repairs contract. However, there have been some issues with CSBE Compliance (see below). In review of the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) evaluation, H&R's average score is 2.9 out of a possible score of 4.0.

## **Compliance Data**

H&R had a Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) goal deficit of \$220,981 for the Airport and other Miami-Dade County contracts. A CSBE make-up was approved by the Department of Small Business Development (SBD) on January 25, 2008. SBD reported in a memorandum dated June 18, 2008 (attached) that H&R has since complied with all open violations as of June 17, 2008.

## **Background**

The Pavement Repair Invitation to Bid MDAD-6-07/09 was advertised on December 17, 2007, for a qualified firm (Contractor) to provide pavement repair and reconstruction services at Miami International, Opa-Locka Executive, Kendall-Tamiami Executive, Homestead General Aviation, and

Transition and Training Airports. Three bids were received on January 30, 2008 from the following firms: H & R Paving, Inc.; ABC Construction, Inc.; and General Asphalt Company, Inc.

SBD evaluated each firm's Schedule of Intent Affidavit which denotes their commitment to meet or exceed the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) goal of sixteen percent (16%). All three (3) bids were deemed responsive.

On February 1, 2008, MDAD opened the three (3) responsive firms' bid prices. The bid prices are as reflected on the attached bid tabulation. While the contract amount is a not-to-exceed, the bids provided establish the unit prices for forty-two (42) items.

WITNESSETH, that the said Contractor, for and in consideration of the payments hereinafter specified and agreed to be made by the County, hereby covenants and agrees to furnish and deliver all the materials required, to do and perform all the Work and labor, in a satisfactory and workmanlike manner, required to complete each Task Order within the time specified, in strict and entire conformity with the Plans, Technical Specifications and other Contract Documents, which are hereby incorporated by reference, for;

**PROJECT TITLE:** Pavement Repairs

**PROJECT NO:** RM-6-07/09

The Contractor agrees to make payment of all proper charges for labor and materials required in the aforementioned Work, and to defend, indemnify and save harmless the County and all its officers, employees and agents against and from all suits and costs of every kind and description, and from all damages to which the said County or any of its officers, agents and employees may be put, by reason of injury or death to persons or injury to property of others resulting from the performance of said Work, or through the negligence of the Contractor, its officers, agents or employees or through any improper or defective machinery, implements or appliances used by the Contractor, its officers, agents or employees in the aforesaid Work, or through any act or omission on the part of the Contractor, or its officers, agents or employees.

In consideration of these premises, the County hereby agrees to pay to the Contractor for the said Work, when fully completed, the total maximum sum of

Ten-million, twenty-five thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$10,025,000.00),

consisting of the following accepted items or schedules of Work as taken from the Bid Form:

The total maximum Contract amount is subject to such additions and deductions as may be provided for in the Contract Documents. Partial and Final Payments will be made as provided for in the Contract Documents.

**CONTRACT TIME:** The initial term of this Contract is 730 calendar days from the date that MDAD approves and accepts the Contractor's submittal of the Performance and Payment Bond, and proof of the required Insurance. The Miami-Dade Aviation Department, at its option, may extend the Contract for up to two (2) additional one-year periods beyond the Contract Time and to fund each renewal period from the Dedicated Allowance Account. The Owner reserves the right to notify the Contractor within one-hundred and eighty (180) days, but not less than one-hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the expiration of the initial, or extended, term of its intent to extend the Contract.

**TASK ORDER TIME:** Completion of the work with the Task Order Time is of the essence. The duration for each project will be defined by each Task Order and the project will commence from the date of issuance of the Task Order.

**TASK ORDER NIGHTTIME OPERATIONS:** At Miami International Airport only, the Contractor must complete any work specified to be performed during nighttime hours, starting at 11:00 P.M., and open the runway or taxiway to aircraft traffic not later than 7:00 A.M. the following morning.

**LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** Liquidated Damages at the rate established in each non-nighttime operations Task Order [maximum rate of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for work at Miami International Airport and five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) for all other airports per day] will be deducted from the Task Order amount for each calendar day of delay due to a Non-Excusable Delay.

**ADDITIONAL LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR NIGHTTIME OPERATIONS:** At Miami International Airport only, Liquidated Damages at the rate established in each nighttime operations Task Order [maximum rate of two-thousand dollars

(\$2,000.00) per quarter hour] will be deducted from the Task Order amount for each quarter hour or fraction thereof, of delay in the daily opening of the runway or taxiway to aircraft traffic beyond the specified time.

**LIQUIDATED INDIRECT COSTS:** Liquidated Indirect Costs recoverable by the Contractor, shall be at the rate established in each Task Order [maximum rate of five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) per day] for a period not greater than twenty-five percent (25%) of the Task Order duration due to a Compensable Excusable Delay.

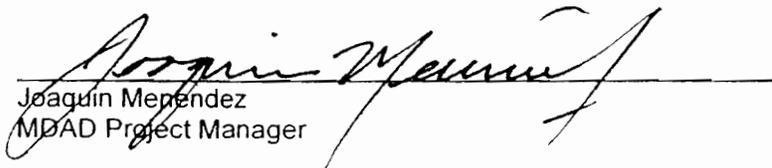

The Department of Small Business Development has reviewed H & R Paving, Inc.'s (H&R) compliance with Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) make-up requirements to determine if a make-up should be a condition of the award of Project No. RM-6-07/09. H&R has a CSBE make-up requirement of \$220,981 on its record. It has approved CSBE make-up plans on Public Works Project No. 20040398 and Water and Sewer Department Project No. W-897 Divisions 1 and 2 which are being recommended for award on the April 15, 2008 Government Operations and Environment Committee agenda. Based on the completion of the above, CSBE make-up requirements should be satisfied and a make-up should not be a condition of award for Project No. RM-6-07/09.

Please be advised that on May 23, 2007, SBD staff issued a Notices of Violation to H&R for inaccurate payrolls and began an audit of H&R's records to determine the amount of underpayment of wages to employees on five projects (20040450, 20040506, 20040507, 20040508 and 20040509). In accordance with the Responsible Wages and Benefits Ordinances, a stop payment of H&R's final invoice for payment has been issued to protect the wages that may be due to the employees. Since then, H&R has provided additional payroll documents to SBD and has attended several meetings with SBD staff in order to clarify how the calculations for the employees pay were made. This audit has not been finalized.

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Small Business Development (SBD) has completed its review of compliance for the above-referenced project with the Community Small Business Enterprise Program (CSBE). The contract measure applicable to this project is a 16% CSBE Goal.

The Miami-Dade Aviation Department submitted bid documents from General Asphalt Company, Inc., ABC Construction, Inc., and H&R Paving, Inc., for compliance review.

General Asphalt Company, Inc. submitted a Schedule of Intent Affidavit committing to utilize Construction Group Corporation a certified CSBE firm to perform concrete work at 9% and Roberts Traffic Corporation, a certified CSBE firm to perform striping work at 8%. General Asphalt Company, Inc. has fulfilled the required contract measure and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

ABC Construction Group, Inc., a certified CSBE firm submitted a Schedule of Intent Affidavit committing to utilize Roberts Traffic Corporation, a certified CSBE firm to perform pavement markings and marking removal work at 5.8%, Ruben Electric Technology, Inc., a certified CSBE firm to perform electrical work at 2.3% and Quality Construction Performance, Inc., a certified CSBE firm to perform milling and pavement work at 11.3 %. ABC Construction Group, Inc. has fulfilled the required contract measure and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

H&R Paving, Inc. (H & R) submitted a Schedule of Intent Affidavit committing to utilize CEB Construction, Inc. a certified CSBE firm to perform concrete, site, and restoration work at 16%. H&R Paving, Inc. has fulfilled the required contract measure and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions. However, be advised that H&R Paving, Inc. has a Goal Deficit for other Miami Dade County contracts. In the event that H & R is the lowest responsive/responsible bidder, the goal deficit needs to be addressed.

HNTB has completed the bid analysis and recommendation for award. Enclosed you will find the Bid Tabulation Summary and the Bid Tabulation Analysis.

The enclosed documentation shows the lowest bid to be H & R Paving, Inc. with a total corrected bid amount of \$7,018,730.00. This represents a cost of approximately 7% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$7,550,800.00. The bids ranged from \$7,018,730.00 to \$9,930,350.00.

The comparison of bid item unit prices provides information on the lowest, highest and average prices for each bid item along with the Engineer's estimate price for each bid item. The tabulation analysis shows the bid item unit prices and totals as submitted by the contractors. The bid amounts were verified by multiplying the unit quantities by the bid item unit prices provided by the contractors. H & R paving had a math error in the bid amount column of line item 25. This error was corrected in the corrected amount column.
