## RECOMMENDATION

This Award Recommendation for the Orange Line Phase I - Miami Intermodal Center - Earlington Heights Connector Project - Construction, Engineering and Inspection Services - Contract No. NCP004-TR07-CT1, between Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc., and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by Miami-Dade Transit (MDT). Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

**Delegation of Authority** - The authority of the County Mayor or his designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County. Additional delegation of authorities requested for this contract are as follows:

## SCOPE

**PROJECT NAME:** Orange Line Phase I - MIC - Earlington Heights Connector Project - Construction, Engineering and Inspection Services

**PROJECT NO:** E07-MDT-02 (PTP)

**CONTRACT NO:** NCP004-TR07-CT1

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc. is to provide Construction Engineering and Inspection (CE&I) Services to Miami-Dade Transit for the construction of the Orange Line Phase I - MIC - Earlington Heights Connector Metrorail Extension Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"). The Project is an elevated 2.4 mile double-track, heavy-rail extension of the existing Miami-Dade County Metrorail System which will connect the MIC, located north of NW 21st Street and east of NW 42nd Avenue, to the existing elevated guide way just west of the Earlington Heights Metrorail station located at NW 41st Street and NW 22nd Avenue. The Project includes one new Metrorail Station at the MIC and provides a direct

link to Downtown Miami from the MIC. The corridor begins in the west at the existing elevated Metrorail line and runs along the north side of SR 112, crosses SR112 and then makes a southerly turn and crosses over the Miami River Canal. It then crosses over the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC) and parallels the SFRC and enters into the MIC.

Additionally, the Project includes the following four (4) FDOT components: Central Station West Concourse, Central Station Vestibule, Bus Plaza and Bus Plaza Roadway. The FDOT project components are located at and/or within close proximity of the three (3) Level Metrorail Station at the MIC.

The CE&I Services cover all fixed facilities and systems elements including resident engineering, office engineering, inspection services, contract administration, construction safety and security, quality control, contractor progress monitoring, construction cost estimates, contractor schedule analyses, contractor claims analyses, construction surveys, rail system testing services, rail system start-up services, and providing all necessary and related professional services.

CE&I Services will be required for the entire duration of the construction contract, which includes Fixed Facilities Construction, Systems Design, Furnish and Installation, System Testing, Start-Up, and Contract Closeout phases of the Project. The duration of the contract is for approximately 1,200 calendar days beginning in the last quarter of 2008.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The proposed connector between the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) and the existing Earlington Heights (EHT) Metrorail Station alignment branches from the existing Earlington Heights Metrorail Station westbound over NW 27th Avenue parallels SR 112 and begins a southward path just west of NW 37th Avenue. The alignment crosses the Miami River just east of the existing South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC) Bridge, continuing southbound and terminating at the MIC, with an elevated passenger station east of the MIC's Rental Car Facility and a tail track south of the station. The FDOT project components are located at and/or within close proximity of the three (3) Level Metrorail Station.

**EXPLANATION:** A Request to Advertise for this Project was approved on January 30, 2008, and the Notice to Professional Consultants was issued on February 8, 2008.

The consultant selection criteria was based on the following qualifications: Qualifications of firms including the team members assigned to the project; Knowledge and past experience of similar type projects; Past performance of the firms; Amount of work awarded and paid by the County; Ability of team members to interface with the County. This last qualification deals with the team's communication capabilities, proximity with the project, commitment to satisfy the County's requirements and familiarity with County guidelines.

At the First-Tier meeting held on April 3, 2008, the Competitive Selection Committee (CSC) ranked the three highest ranking firms out of the three (3) proposals received. The Committee ranked Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc., as the highest ranking firm. The CSC waived the Second-Tier selection process and made a final recommendation that a contract be negotiated with the highest-ranked, responsive and responsible proposer based on the first-tier criteria only.

The total points based on the Selection Committees' final ranking were as follows:

The Negotiation Committee was approved by the County Manager on April 18, 2008. On May 22, 2008 the Negotiation Committee met with Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc., and concluded its negotiations.

Based on the Office of Capital Improvements CIIS database, the County has completed one evaluation for Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc., with an overall performance rating of 3.0 points out of a possible 4 points.

Knowledgeable of and experience with applying the American Rail Engineering & Maintenance Association standards and guidelines. The Resident Engineer shall have experience in managing complex rail transit and/or transportation construction projects similar to the nature, size, and scope of the MIC-Earlington Heights Connector Metrorail Extension Project. The CE&I Team must have experienced Train Control, Traction Power and Communications personnel on their staff. The CE&I Team is required to staff a Special Inspector, duly registered by the State of Florida to carry out the required inspections to obtain the Certification of Occupancy.

These additional requirements are necessary to ensure a well qualified and experienced team in the area of rail transit construction oversight and inspection.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Construction, Engineering and Inspection (CE&I) Services for the Project are a vital component of the Orange Line Phase I - Miami Intermodal Center - Earlington Heights Connector Project.

As outlined in the Scope of Services, the selected firm will perform the following services: resident engineering services, processing shop drawings, negotiating of change proposals, monitoring schedules, processing of progress payments and project close-out; ensuring compliance with quality control, testing and safety procedures; analyzing contractual claims, and providing recommendations for the County; coordinating and complying with Federal Transportation Agency (FTA), Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requirements and performing any other miscellaneous tasks as required.

The MIC-Earlington Heights Connector project was programmed at \$523 million in the FY 07-08 adopted budget. Of that amount, \$100 million is funded by FDOT and \$423 million from the Charter County System Surtax. The total project cost of \$526 million will be included in the FY 08-09 proposed capital plan. The total project increase of \$3 million is funded by the Charter County System Surtax.

MDT received an additional \$22.8 million in FDOT funds through a second Joint Participation Agreement (JPA), not included in the original Project summary (R-644-08). This additional JPA will encompass the following components: Central Station West Concourse, Central Station Vestibule and Bus Plaza Roadway. Should FDOT funds not become available, MDT shall have the option to remove these components from the Project.



**GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT**

The services requested include performing Construction, Engineering and Inspection Services for the construction of the Orange Line Phase I – MIC –Earlington Heights Connector Metrorail Extension Project. The project is an elevated 2.4 miles of double-track, heavy-rail extension of the existing Miami-Dade County Metrorail System which will connect the MIC, located north of the NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street and east of NW 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, to the existing elevated guide way just west of the Earlington Heights Metrorail station located at NW 41<sup>st</sup> Street and NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. The project also includes the following four (4) FDOT components that are essential to the success of this project which are located at and/or within close proximity of the three (3) levels Metrorail Station at the MIC: Central Station West Concourse, Central Station Vestibule, Bus Plaza and Bus Plaza Roadway.

**TOTAL COST AND SOURCE OF FUNDING**

Total amount under this Agreement is limited to a maximum of \$20,845,995.50, which includes an allowance account in the amount of \$1,895,090.50, for all services described in the General Description of the Project, above. The total cost of services will be defrayed from funds allocated for that purpose by Miami-Dade Transit from state sources and the County's Transit System Sales Surtax.

### SELECTION PROCESS

The Consultant Selection process was conducted in accordance with Section 2-10.4 (6) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, as authorized by the County Manager's memoranda dated April 15, 2008.

The designated Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) met on May 28, 2008 with Pistorino & Alam Consulting Engineers, Inc., and concluded its negotiations.

The CSC recommendations were submitted to the Office of the County Manager on April 8, 2008. The Negotiation Committee, appointed by the County Manager, undertook and successfully completed negotiations of the attached Agreement on May 28, 2008.

### NEGOTIATION PROCESS AND CONSULTANT FEES

The first negotiation meeting with the Consultant was held on May 2, 2008 to discuss the scope of work. No further negotiation meetings were conducted on this Agreement.

At the May 28, 2008 meeting, the CSC passed a motion to approve the total amount for this Agreement not to exceed \$20,845,995.50. This amount includes the allowance account of \$1,895,090.50.

A Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) utilization goal of twenty percent (20%) has been established for this contract.

### TIMETABLE

Upon final execution of this professional Services Agreement, the agreement shall remain in full force and effect for a period of Forty (40) months. This Agreement will be administered by MDT on a Work Order basis.



Miami-Dade Transit is preparing a Notice to Professional Consultants (NTPC) for Construction, Engineering Inspection Services (CE&I) in connection with the MIC-Earlington Heights Connector Project. The total estimated cost is \$17,314,000.00. This project will be partially funded with Federal, State and Local dollars.

After reviewing the scope of this project, which among other things consists of office engineering, inspection services, contract administration, construction safety and security, quality control, contractor claims analyses, rail system testing services, and furnish and install system testing for start-up and Contract Closeout phases of the project, we have determined that this project does have discernible subcontracting possibilities. Accordingly and based on the foregoing, a DBE goal of TWENTY (20%) percent is a reasonable goal to be established for this contract.

Upon careful consideration and examination of the Department of Small Business Development ("SBD") list of certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprises ("DBE") firms within this market area, we have identified three or more available certified DBE firms that are by reason of their certification ready, willing and able to provide the services requested on each item in the scope of work. Accordingly, we recommend a TWENTY (20%) DBE goal for this project.



The above-referenced item was originally submitted for analysis by the Review Committee (RC) on June 6, 2007, and a 23% goal was assessed.

Due to a change in the project's scope and a decrease in cost, on July 9, 2007, Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) forwarded a second request for RC review. Subsequently, on July 18, 2007, a 23% CBE goal was recommended.

The funding sources for the project are noted as Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Sunshine State Financing and People's Transportation Plan (PTP). Due to a delay with the construction of the project, the CE&I Consultant Services component was on hold for approximately five (5) months.

In an attempt to finalize the Request to Advertise for this project, MDT staff noted that the Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with the FDOT, according to Section 12.30 attached, specifies that Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of this contract.

To that end, staff will work with MDT's Office of Civil Rights for their analysis and recommendations; this information will be forwarded to your office.

Therefore, it is requested that the Review Committee remove the 23% Community Business Enterprise (CBE) goal from the MIC-Earlington Heights Connector Project – CE&I Consultant Services, Project No. E07-MDT-2, Contract No. NFP004-TR07-CT1.


