RESOLUTION DEDICATING THE MIAMI-DADE FIRE
RESCUE DEPARTMENT LOGISTICS FACILITY LOCATED
AT 6000 S.W. 87th AVENUE IN HONOR OF LIEUTENANT
GRANT PORTER

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Grant Porter was born in Miami-Dade County and served Miami-Dade County with honor and distinction; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Porter was never content to leave things the same and was always looking for ways to make a situation better; and

WHEREAS, while in college, Lieutenant Porter decided to become a firefighter and dedicate his life to helping his fellow human beings; and

WHEREAS, during Hurricane Andrew, Lieutenant Porter compiled a book of maps to assist Fire Rescue units in finding locations during alarms even though street signs and traffic signals were no longer in place; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Porter was given multiple Employee Suggestion Program (E.S.P.) awards and worked his last six years as a Support Officer working to improve the equipment of firefighters; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Porter tragically passed away recently while working on projects to further improve the ways the Fire Rescue Department serves the community; and

WHEREAS, this proposed facility dedication is located in County Commission District 7,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Finds that Lieutenant Grant Porter has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community and approves the dedication of the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Logistics Facility located at 6000 S.W. 87th Avenue to the memory of Lieutenant Grant Porter.

Section 2. Directs the Mayor or Designee to install suitable signage and/or markers dedicating the new Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Logistics Facility located at 6000 S.W. 87th Avenue to the memory of Lieutenant Grant Porter.
