Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopt the subject Resolution designating a portion of Miami-Dade County owned property as road right-of-way for the intersection of SW 122 Avenue and SW 144 Street, in Section 24, Township 55 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

The subject property is located within Commission District 9.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.



Background

The property to be designated as road right-of-way is a radius return located in the Southeast quadrant of the intersection of SW 122 Avenue and SW 144 Street. Said property is owned by Miami-Dade County's Department of Park and Recreation (DPR) and currently used as part of Deerwood Bonita Lakes Park. The subject property was donated to DPR for park purposes, and since DPR has filed a Tentative Plat with the Public Works Department (PWD), as part of the development requirements, DPR needs to dedicate the radius return at the subject intersection. This road designation will improve traffic safety in the area by providing better visibility of vehicular cross traffic.

The Directors of DPR and PWD agree as to the public benefits to be derived from the designation of this parcel for road right-of-way purposes.
