RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR
OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO CONDUCT A
STUDY REGARDING THE FEASIBILITY AND
ADVISABILITY OF INSTALLING TIME BOARDS AT
CERTAIN BUS SHELTERS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Broward County Transit has recently unveiled a new "real-time" notification system using LED time boards at two bus stops on U.S. 441; and

WHEREAS, cellular technology continuously updates these time boards with GPS data from Broward buses, sending a signal to display and announce through a speaker when the next bus will arrive; and

WHEREAS, Broward County's pilot program is modeled after time boards in other metropolitan areas in the United States, as well as cities overseas; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the system is to help relieve passenger anxiety while waiting for a bus, as well as eliminate the need to check the schedule or call the customer information line; and

WHEREAS, another objective of the time boards is to expand ridership; and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes that a study regarding the feasibility and advisability of installing time boards at the County's busiest bus shelters is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to conduct a study regarding the

feasibility and advisability of installing time boards at the County's busiest bus shelters. A report regarding the Mayor's findings and recommendations shall be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners within 60 days after the adoption of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
