Subject: Establishment of the Joseph Caleb Auditorium Trust Fund

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution authorizing the establishment of the Joseph Caleb Auditorium (Caleb Auditorium) Trust Fund for the receipt and expenditure of revenues collected as a surcharge on tickets sold for events held at the auditorium. These funds will be used for renovation improvements and purchase of small technical equipment for the facility.

Scope

The Caleb Auditorium is located at 5400 N. W. 22 Avenue, in Commission District 3. The auditorium operates as a professional theatre. Events held there are patronized by visitors and residents from all segments of Miami-Dade County.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact to the County to establish this trust fund.

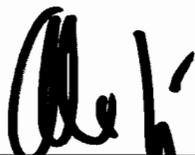
Track Record/Monitor

Expenditures and revenues to the Caleb Auditorium Trust Fund will be monitored monthly by the Park and Recreation Department (MDPR), Finance Division. This is consistent with the current monthly reporting process for existing MDPR trust funds.

Background

The Caleb Auditorium is a 991 seat performing arts facility that is the center of many community programs and activities for all ages and events. The auditorium opened in 1978 to provide a cultural center for the community of Liberty City and today holds a unique place in Miami-Dade County as a state-of-the-art medium-sized auditorium that caters to artists and audiences alike.

The Board has approved a non-taxable Ticketed Event Surcharge of \$1.00 per ticket, for events held at the Caleb Auditorium. Approval of the Trust Fund will allow for the disbursement of these surcharge funds collected solely for the benefit of the Caleb Auditorium.

WHEREAS, this Board has previously approved a nontaxable Ticket Event
Surcharge of \$1.00 per ticket for events held at the Joseph Caleb Auditorium; and

WHEREAS, the surcharge funds collected are to be used solely for renovations
and the purchase of small technical equipment for the Joseph Caleb Auditorium; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the
accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

the establishment of a Trust Fund Account for the expenditure of ticket surcharge
