Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) grant the road closure requested by the Public Works Department following a public hearing. The Miami-Dade County Departments of Planning and Zoning, Public Works, Water and Sewer and Fire Rescue have no objection to this right-of-way being closed.

Scope

This road closing is located within Commission District 2.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

All the properties abutting the right-of-way to be abandoned are tax exempt. Therefore, this road closure will not result in an increase in revenue from property taxes. Since the subject road closing is initiated by Public Works Department there is no fee associated with it.

Track Record/Monitor

Not Applicable.

Background

The Director of the Public Works Department pursuant to the functions, powers and duties prescribed in Article XIV, Sec. 2-100 (a), (b) and (c) of the Code of Miami-Dade County Volume I, has taken the initiative to request that the Board of County Commissioners grant the closing of NW 34 Street, from NW 36 Avenue West for approximately 404 feet to incorporate it to the abutting property to maximize the use of the land. The western portion of this road was closed by Resolution R-1317-77.

The subject right-of-way was dedicated in 1925, by the plat of "MELROSE HEIGHTS", as recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 22, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The area surrounding the subject right-of-way is zoned RU-3B (Bungalow Court District), BU-2 (Special Business District) and IU-1 (Light Industry District).

RESOLUTION GRANTING CLOSURE OF NW 34
STREET, FROM NW 36 AVENUE WEST FOR
APPROXIMATELY 404 FEET

WHEREAS, the County Commission held a public hearing to consider closure of NW 34 Street, from NW 36 Avenue West for approximately 404 feet, as outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, (1) that the avenue, street, road, highway or other place used for travel as described in the attached petition is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed, save and except that the land is reserved as a utility easement; (2) it is found that the action will serve a public purpose and benefit the public without violating private property rights; (3) that the procedure utilized in the adoption of this resolution is expressly ratified and approved; and (4) the Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the adoption of this resolution one time within thirty (30) days hereafter in a newspaper of general circulation of Miami-Dade County.

INFORMATION OF ROAD TO BE CLOSED

1. LEGAL DESCRIPTION: The complete and accurate legal description of the road, right-of-way sought to be closed is as follows:

That portion of NW 34th Street bounded by the south line of Block 70 of “MELROSE HEIGHTS”, recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 22, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, bounded by the north line of Block 69 of said Plat of “MELROSE HEIGHTS”, bounded on the west by a line from the southwest corner of Lot 19, of said Block 70 to the northwest corner of Lot 8, of said Block 69, and bounded on the east by a line 30.00 feet west of the centerline of NW 36 Avenue (NW 34 Avenue by said Plat).

2. PUBLIC INTEREST IN ROAD: The title or interest of the county and the Public in and to the above described right-of-way was acquired in the following manner: This right of ways was dedicated to the county in 1925, by the plat of “MELROSE HEIGHTS”, recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 22, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

3. ATTACH LOCATION SKETCH: Attached hereto is a sketch showing the above described right-of-way and its location and relation to surrounding property.

4. ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS: the following constitutes a complete and accurate schedule of all owners of property abutting upon the above described road, right-of-way.

6. Grounds for requesting this Road Closing and proposed use for the land:

This portion of NW 34 Street is not being used. Aviation Department owns all lots abutting said portion of the right of way and by closing it the use of the land can be maximized. The western portion of this road was previously closed (Resolution R-1317-77).
