

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE AUGUST 16, 2008 “2ND ANNUAL BACK TO SCHOOL BASH” SPONSORED BY DADE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,336.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 2 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Dade Community Foundation, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the August 16, 2008 “2nd Annual Back to School Bash” event in an amount not to exceed \$1,336.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the “2nd Annual Back to School Bash” is to provide inner-city children with backpacks and school supplies, and to provide education regarding gun control and gun violence; and

WHEREAS, the Dade Community Foundation, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the “2nd Annual Back to School Bash” event is a small event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,336.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 2 In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the August 16, 2008 “2nd Annual Back to School Bash” event in an amount not to exceed \$1,336.00 to be funded from the District 2 In-kind Reserve Fund.







Subject: District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization the Dade Community Foundation, Inc. for the "2nd Annual – Back to School Bash" event held on August 16, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$1,336 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a sound system and one (1) show mobile. This event will be funded from the District 2 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2007-08, the Dade Community Foundation, Inc. has received \$245,000 from the General Fund, \$10,000 from District 7 discretionary reserve, and \$10,000 from District 8 discretionary reserve.
