Subject: Resolution Authorizing the County Mayor or designee to Receive and Expend \$14,781 in State Grants Funds from the State of Florida Division of Cultural Affairs' 2008-2009 Local Arts Agencies Program

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board authorize the County Mayor or designee to receive and expend a grant award in the amount of \$14,781 from the State of Florida Division of Cultural Affairs' FY2008-2009 Local Arts Agencies Program for General Program Support to the Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs.

Scope

The impact of this agenda item is countywide.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source


This State grant, No. 09-8017, has been awarded to address administrative and program support of the Department's programs, activities and initiatives for the grant period of October 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009. The Department's existing FY2008-2009 administrative budget provides the required \$1:\$1 match for the grant.

Track Record/Monitor

The Department of Cultural Affairs has an excellent record of complying with the State's contractual requirements and has been recognized as one of the top local arts agencies in the State of Florida. The Department applies for and receives annual funding from the State of Florida Division of Cultural Affairs to assist with general programs and activities. Michael Spring, Director of the Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs, is responsible for monitoring the grant contract.

Background

The State of Florida Division of Cultural Affairs' Local Arts Agencies Program operates on a four-year cycle and provides general operating support for local arts agencies. A comprehensive application and review process was conducted by the State for FY2008-2009. The FY2008-2009 grant amount of \$14,781 is intended to define a grant level until FY2011-2012, contingent upon the availability of funding, and upon the Department's fulfillment of interim year application/reporting requirements and accepted as satisfactory by the State. The Department continues to fulfill all State application and reporting requirements.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND \$14,781 IN STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS' FY2008-2009 LOCAL ARTS AGENCIES PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO EXERCISE CANCELLATION PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the County Mayor or designee to receive and expend State grant funds for the period October 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$14,781 from the State of Florida Division of Cultural Affairs' Local Arts Agencies Program for General Program Support for the Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs, in substantially the form of the grant award letter attached hereto and made a part hereof; and authorizes the County Mayor or designee to execute same for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County; and to exercise cancellation provisions contained therein.
