

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 8-16, 2008 "MIAMI BOOK FAIR INTERNATIONAL" SPONSORED BY THE MIAMI BOOK FAIR INTERNATIONAL, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Miami Book Fair International, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Public Works Department for the November 8-16, 2008 Miami Book Fair International event in an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the Miami Book Fair International is an annual literary festival designed to encourage writing and promote the awareness of literature and books; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Book Fair International, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Book Fair International event is a major event, as defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application and the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,







Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Miami Book Fair International, Inc. for the "Annual Literary Festival" scheduled for November 8-16, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 from the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department for permit fees. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve.

In FY 2008-09, the Miami Book Fair International, Inc. has received \$92,306 from the Department of Cultural Affairs and \$65,625 from the General Fund.
