RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN ECONOMIC STIMULUS PLAN FOR DISTRICT 2 TO EXPEDITE STATE AND COUNTY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS LOCATED THEREIN

WHEREAS, Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for September, 2008 was 6.6 percent, which is up 2.4 percentage points from September, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's unemployment rate for September, 2008 was 6.0 percent, which is up 1.9 percentage points from September, 2007; and

WHEREAS, expediting State and County infrastructure projects can provide jobs and act as a stimulus to the local economy at a time when such action is greatly needed; and

WHEREAS, expediting State and County infrastructure projects would also provide the public infrastructure necessary to help the economy recover; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of State and County infrastructure projects located in District 2 that could be expedited, including among others the following:

1. Triplex (Library, Police, Community Action Agency Administration Building);
2. Arcola Lakes Senior Center;
3. Sidewalks, Drainage, and Resurfacing projects (QNIP);
4. Hope VI;
5. Haitian Center/ Oak Grove Renovations;
6. Poinciana Industrial Park Recycling Center proposal;
7. Poinciana Industrial Park Health Center (State);
8. Beautification Rehabilitation Program bounded by N.W. 7th Avenue to the east; N.W. 17th Avenue to the west; N.W. 62nd Street to the south; and N.W. 79th Street to the north;

9. Beautification Program (Super Bowl funding);
10. Gwen Cherry Park (pool, tennis courts);
11. Center Court Apartments;
12. Transit Village; at N.W. 79th Street and N.W. 32nd Avenue
13. \$10 million Water/Sewer Bond projects;
14. Florida Department of Transportation, I-95 entrance and exit beautification and maintenance improvements;
15. Street lights on main thoroughfares, N.W. 27th Avenue, N.W. 22 Avenue, N.W. 17th Avenue and N.W. 7th Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the Mayor or Designee to develop and implement an economic stimulus plan for District 2 to expedite State and County infrastructure projects located in District 2.

Section 2. Directs the Mayor or designee to provide an implementation strategy to the Board within thirty (30) days of the date of this resolution.


