

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 167<sup>th</sup> AVENUE FROM  
SW 88<sup>th</sup> STREET TO SW 104<sup>th</sup> STREET AS “ARCHBISHOP  
COLEMAN F. CARROLL AVENUE”

**WHEREAS**, Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll was the first Bishop and later Archbishop of Miami, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1958, Pope Pius XII appointed Bishop Carroll the first Bishop of the newly created Diocese of Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, Bishop Carroll would lay the foundation that would allow the Catholic church to grow through thousands of Cuban refugees coming to Miami, the American Civil Rights Movement, the Vietnam War and the reformations of the Second Vatican Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Bishop Carroll created the Catholic Service Bureau, now known as Catholic Charities, to serve as a social network; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1968, Miami was made an Archdiocese by Pope Paul VI, and Bishop Carroll became the Archbishop and served in that capacity until his death on July 26, 1977; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1998, a new Catholic high school was opened in Miami-Dade County and was named after Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll; and

**WHEREAS**, Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll High School continues to thrive educating the children of West Dade; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 167<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 88<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,  
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 167<sup>th</sup> Avenue from SW 88<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street as Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll Avenue.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
