RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 93RD AVENUE
FROM SW 40TH STREET TO SW 44TH STREET AS "PABLO
RAMIREZ AVENUE"

WHEREAS, Pablo Ramirez arrived in Miami in 1960 and immediately joined Brigade 2506, disembarking in Playa Giron, Cuba, on April 17, 1961; and

WHEREAS, Pablo Ramirez was taken prisoner and was held until he was liberated in December of 1962; and

WHEREAS, after arriving back in the United States, he was a founding member of the Veteran's Association of Brigade 2506 and the Committee for Cuban Political Prisoners, providing help to families Brigade 2506 veterans; and

WHEREAS, through his efforts, SW 13th Avenue was co-designated "Cuban Memorial Boulevard" and the monument at the corner of SW 13th Avenue and SW 8th Street is lighted with an eternal flame; and

WHEREAS, Pablo Ramirez worked continuously on behalf of others, such as by assisting senior citizens at the Activity Center of Little Havana or assisting needy families with newborn children through the Cuban Masons; and

WHEREAS, SW 93rd Avenue from SW 40th Street to SW 44th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Pablo Ramirez with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed co-designation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, co-designates SW 93rd Avenue from SW 40th Street to SW 44th Street as “Pablo Ramirez Avenue.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
