

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 20, 2008 “SNEAK PREVIEW OF AMAZON & BEYOND” SPONSORED BY THE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF FLORIDA, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,020.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Zoological Society of Florida has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department for the November 20, 2008 “Sneak Preview of Amazon & Beyond” event in an amount not to exceed \$2,020.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the “Sneak Preview of Amazon & Beyond” is to provide a preview of the spectacular Amazon & Beyond exhibition at Miami Metrozoo; and

WHEREAS, the Zoological Society of Florida is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the “Sneak Preview of Amazon & Beyond” is a special event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$2,020.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Zoological Society of Florida for their "Sneak Preview of Amazon & Beyond" event held on November 20, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$2,020 from the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department for the use of (2) two tower lights. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, the Zoological Society of Florida has received \$327,724 from the General Fund. In addition, the organization has requested \$2,020 from the Countywide In-kind Reserve for the December 5, 2008 Amazon and Beyond Opening Ceremony.
