RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DECEMBER 13, 2008 "BBBS CHILDREN'S HOLIDAY PARTY" EVENT SPONSORED BY THE BIG BROTHERS/BIG SISTERS OF GREATER MIAMI, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,630.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

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



**Subject:** Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

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The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Greater Miami, Inc. for their "BBBS Children's Holiday Party" event held on December 13, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$6,630 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the Miami Metrozoo fee waiver. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Greater Miami, Inc. has received \$55,250 from the General Fund.
