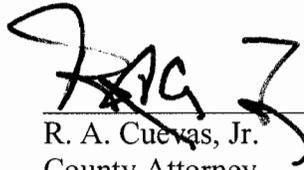

RESOLUTION WAIVING MIAMI-DADE WATER AND
SEWER DEPARTMENT'S REQUIREMENT FOR
INSTALLATION OF A 12-INCH WATER MAIN EXTENSION
FOR A DENTIST OFFICE AT 504 BILTMORE WAY

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department's ("Department") Rules and Regulations for Water and Sewer Service provides that service requests to existing structures where the change in use increases the existing total daily rated gallonage by 50 percent or more must improve the water facilities by installing a 12-inch water main extension; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Jose Abadin has applied for a new Certificate of Use intending to reuse a retail space for a dental office within an existing building located at 504 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, the Department applies a rate of flows of 5 gallons per day for every 100 square feet for shopping centers (dry use) and 275 gallons per day for dentist offices pursuant to the Department's Schedule of Rates, Fees and Charges; and

WHEREAS, said rate of flows causes the calculated flows for the existing building to increase by more than fifty percent over the existing flows which requires the installation of a new 12-inch water main extension; and

WHEREAS, the subject dentist office will be constructed to meet new flow reductions specified in Section 8-31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County through the installation of water efficient fixtures, including water conserving toilets and waterless dental equipment, that result in significant reductions in flows; and

WHEREAS, the Department is in the process of submitting for this Board's approval revised and updated language to the Rules and Regulations which will not require the installation of a 12-inch water main in situations such as the dentist office in the instant case,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board waives the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department's Rules and Regulations requiring a 12-inch water main extension for a dentist office at 504 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
