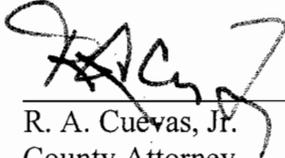

THE TRANSIT, INFRASTRUCTURE AND ROADS
COMMITTEE TO SCHEDULE QUARTERLY TRANSIT
SUMMITS AND INVITE INTERESTED PARTIES TO
PARTICIPATE

WHEREAS, the County Mayor and members of the Board of County Commissioners hosted a public transportation summit on November 15, 2008 to address the People's Transportation Plan and inform the public of the accomplishments of the half-penny surtax and the transit challenges and opportunities ahead; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners seeks to continue the ongoing dialogue on transit issues with federal, state, and local officials as well as concerned members of the community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or his designee is hereby directed to coordinate with the Chairperson of the Transit, Infrastructure and Roads Committee to schedule quarterly transit summits and invite interested parties to participate in order to discuss transit issues impacting Miami-Dade County.
