RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 26, 2008 "1<sup>ST</sup> ANNUAL GATOR BOWL GAME" EVENT SPONSORED BY HOMESTEAD MIDDLE SCHOOL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,195.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 9 IN-KIND RESERVE FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, Homestead Middle School, has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the November 26, 2008 "1<sup>st</sup> Annual Gator Bowl Game" in an amount not to exceed \$3,195.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the "1<sup>st</sup> Annual Gator Bowl Game" is to reward students at Homestead Middle School for major improvements in the areas of behavior, attendance and academics; and

**WHEREAS**, the "1<sup>st</sup> Annual Gator Bowl Game" is a district event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$3,195.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Funds,





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## Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization the Homestead Middle School for their "1<sup>st</sup> Annual Gator Bowl" event held on November 26, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$3,195 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of two (2) bleachers. This event will be funded from District 9 in-kind reserve funds.
