

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE JANUARY 24, 2009 “WILLIS MCGAHEE FLAG FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT AND MUSICAL FESTIVAL” SPONSORED BY GWEN CHERRY PARK FOUNDATION, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,702.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the January 24, 2009 “Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament and Music Festival” in an amount not to exceed \$27,702.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the “Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament and Music Festival” is to, among other things, raise funds for the Gwen Cheery Park Foundation and support after-school programs and services for inner city youth; and

WHEREAS, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the “Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament and Music Festival” is a major event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$27,702.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the January 24, 2009 “Willis McGahee Flag Football

Tournament and Music Festival” in an amount not to exceed \$27,702.00 to be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund.



Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization Gwen Cherry Park Foundation, Inc. for their "Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament and Music Festival" event held on January 24, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$3,780 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a 24'X40' stage, two (2) bleachers and a generator and \$23,922 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services for a total in-kind amount of \$27,702. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation, Inc. has received \$1,940 from District 2 discretionary reserve.
