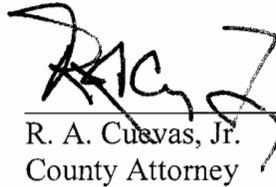

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE A  
REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO CONVERT  
RICKENBACKER CAUSEWAY TO OPEN ROAD AND/OR  
OTHER MODERN TOLLING PROCEDURES

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County has operated the Rickenbacker Causeway for more than sixty years as a toll facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the bonds which financed the Rickenbacker Causeway and all subsequent refinancings have been completely paid off; and

**WHEREAS**, toll collection methodologies have been modernized and upgraded over the years allowing for major improvements in vehicle through put per hour, reduction in cost of collection, increased opportunities for innovative pricing strategies and special rates as determined by this Board; and

**WHEREAS**, recent national studies have found that through put for a manned booth collecting cash average 400 vehicles per hour while Sunpass dedicated lanes are able to allow as many as 1200 cars per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic congestion at the intersection of I-95, Bayshore Drive, Miami Avenue, Brickell (US-1) and the Rickenbacker Causeway continues to worsen; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of collection for open road tolling lanes and/or other modern tolling lanes may be as low as 5-10 percent of collections; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs to operate the Rickenbacker Causeway as per the September 30, 2007, Comprehensive Annual Report for Miami-Dade County, place these costs at approximately 40 percent of collection; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual cost savings and revenue increase for the Rickenbacker Causeway operation from open road tolling and/or other modern tolling procedures may exceed \$3.0 million per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Miami Dade Expressway Authority has vast experience in innovative tolling procedures,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor is directed to prepare a report and recommendations to convert the Rickenbacker Causeway to open road and/or other forms of modern tolling utilizing the Miami Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) as the managing entity for the installation and tolling operations of the Rickenbacker Causeway. Said report shall be presented to the Transit, Infrastructure and Roads Committee during its July meeting and shall include, among other relevant and related matters: (1) analysis of installation costs being financed by MDX, (2) continuing pricing programs for Key Biscayne residents and workers, (3) the potential for paying Crandon Park, Cape Florida and special events parking fees through Sun Pass, and (4) the manner in which toll collectors and related supervisory personnel will be offered other job opportunities.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
