Subject: Recommendation for Approval to Establish Pools RFQ662: County Bond Counsel Pool, RFQ663: Authority Bond Counsel Pool, and RFQ664: Disclosure Counsel Pool

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the establishment of the County Bond Counsel Pool, Authority Bond County Pool and Disclosure Counsel Pool.

POOL NOS. AND TITLES: RFQ662: County Bond Counsel Pool
RFQ663: Authority Bond Counsel Pool
RFQ664: Disclosure Counsel Pool

DESCRIPTION: To establish three Pools, each having up to three joint ventures consisting of a senior law firm and its associate law firm. Firms appointed to the County Bond Counsel Pool shall be assigned exclusively to County bond transactions. Firms appointed to the Authority Bond Counsel Pool shall be assigned exclusively to bond transactions for the County's peripheral authorities. Firms appointed to the Disclosure Counsel Pool shall serve as disclosure counsel for all negotiated and competitively bid County bond transactions on an as needed basis, as well as, serve as the Securities Exchange Commission compliance counsel for one-year intervals on a rotating basis. The County will assign transactions to the Pool members within each Pool on a rotational basis, allowing for equal division of work based on compensation earned and quantity of work.

TERM: Seven years

APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE: December 17, 2008

CONTRACT AMOUNTS: \$7,000,000 County Bond Counsel Pool
\$4,200,000 Authority Bond Counsel Pool
\$4,900,000 Disclosure Counsel Pool

METHOD OF AWARD: Appoint into each pool the three highest ranked responsive, responsible and eligible respondents based on the evaluation criteria established in each solicitation. A selected respondent can only be assigned to one pool. The respondents were selected into pools in the following priority order: County Bond Counsel Pool, Authority Bond Counsel Pool, and Disclosure Counsel Pool. A full and

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open competitive Request for Qualifications process was used for each pool.

Selection to participate in a pool creates an opportunity for that respondent to be considered by the County to serve as counsel, as needed.

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The Authority Bond Counsel Pool solicitation does not contain the 2% User Access Program (UAP) provision as there is no contract resulting from this process for which to apply the UAP.

PROJECT MANAGER: Frank Hinton, Finance Department

ESTIMATED CONTRACT COMMENCEMENT DATE: Ten days after date adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, unless vetoed by the Mayor.

DELEGATED AUTHORITY: If this item is approved, the County Mayor or designee will have the authority to exercise, at County Mayor's or designee's discretion, subsequent options-to-renew and other extensions in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

BACKGROUND

The County utilizes the services of various bond counsels through three pre-qualified pools, each consisting of three selected joint ventures. These pools will replace the current pools. General descriptions of the services are noted below:

County Bond Counsel Pool:


Pool members will structure transactions pursuant to Federal and State law, render an approving opinion that would be accepted by the market place, and serve as special bond counsel from time-to-time on public finance matters involving the County.

Authority Bond Counsel Pool:

Pool members will structure the transactions pursuant to Federal and State law, render an approving opinion that would be accepted by the market place for transactions for the following peripheral authorities: Housing Finance, Industrial Development, and Educational Facilities, and Health Facilities Authorities.

Disclosure Counsel Pool:

Pool members will serve as disclosure counsel. Their responsibilities will include preparation of preliminary and final official statements, negotiation with underwriters, serving as Securities and Exchange Commission compliance counsel on one-year intervals, and serving as special bond counsel from time-to-time on public finance matters involving the County.

The Evaluation/Selection Committees have completed the evaluation of responses submitted in response to the above referenced Request for Qualifications (RFQ) following the guidelines published in the solicitations as summarized below.

The County issued three RFQs to establish three Pools of qualified law firms to serve as bond counsel to the County and its peripheral authorities, and as disclosure counsel to the County.

Other information:

Each Pool shall consist of up to three joint ventures consisting of a senior law firm and its associate law firm. Firms pre-qualified to participate in the County Bond Counsel Pool shall be assigned exclusively to County bond transactions. Firms pre-qualified to participate in the Authority Bond Counsel Pool shall be assigned exclusively to bond transactions for the County's peripheral authorities. Firms pre-qualified to participate in the Disclosure Counsel Pool shall serve as disclosure counsel for all negotiated and competitively bid County bond transactions on an as needed basis, as well as, serve as the Securities Exchange Commission compliance counsel for one-year intervals on a rotating basis. The County will assign transactions to the Pool members within each Pool on a rotational basis, allowing for an equal division of work based on compensation earned and quantity of work.

Two Evaluation/Selection Committees were established for the three Pools. One Evaluation/Selection Committee evaluated RFQ662 and RFQ664 responses and the other evaluated RFQ663 responses.


Justification for Recommendation:
