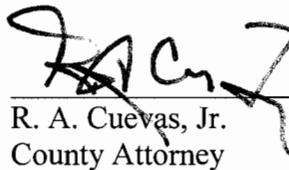

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR’S DESIGNEE TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF CREATING A LANDSCAPE-A-ROADWAY PROGRAM

**WHEREAS,** numerous roadways and traffic calming circles throughout Miami-Dade County contain landscaping which is maintained at a cost to Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS,** landscape maintenance companies, nursery businesses, and other related private sector businesses are struggling in the current economic climate; and

**WHEREAS,** Miami-Dade County has previously implemented a successful Adopt-a-Road program; and

**WHEREAS,** a similarly structured Landscape-A-Roadway program could provide a means by which Miami-Dade County can reduce its landscape maintenance costs by allowing such companies to install and maintain the landscaping in roadways and traffic circles, or alternatively by allowing monetary contributions toward same, while assisting such struggling companies by posting signs recognizing such companies in approved locations; and

**WHEREAS,** a feasibility study will assist in determining whether such a program is a viable means to accomplish such goals; and

**WHEREAS,** a study regarding the feasibility and advisability of a Landscape-A-Roadway program is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to conduct a study as to the feasibility and advisability

of an Landscape-A-Roadway program in Miami-Dade County. The study shall include an analysis by the Public Works Department regarding safety and visibility issues, as well as recommendations for the creation of appropriate signage including all sign specifications. A report containing the findings and recommendations resulting from this study shall be submitted to this Board within 90 days of the adoption of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

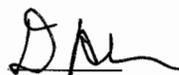
