**Subject:** Resolution Requesting Authority to Exercise Option-to-Renew Periods Under Existing Competitively Bid Contracts that Would Bring the Cumulative Contract Value to More than \$1 Million

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners delegate to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee the authority to exercise, in his discretion, the Options-to-Renew (OTRs) set forth in this item. Ordinance #07-139 provides for committee review exemption. ***Contract amounts and department allocations represent the maximum spending authority based on estimated past usage. This action does not guarantee that the total contract amount/value will be expended by County departments and/or agencies.***

## Scope

The impact of the items in the accompanying OTR package is countywide in nature.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The accompanying OTR package states the allocation amount and funding source for each department utilizing a contract. ***Funding will be expended only if departmental budgets can support the expenditures approved in their Resource Allocation Plan adopted annually by the Board.***

## Track Record/Monitor

There are no known performance issues with vendors recommended for award in the accompanying agenda item. Each departments' contract manager is reflected in the accompanying agenda item.

## Delegated Authority

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise OTRs in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contracts listed in the accompanying package.

## Background

The competitively bid contracts listed in this item require approval to exercise OTRs contained in each contract that would, if exercised, bring the cumulative value of the contract over \$1 million. Each of the contracts were awarded under the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee's delegated authority (\$1 million for competitive procurements) pursuant to Section 2-8.1(b) of the County Code and the Master Procurement Administrative Order, A.O. 3-38.

**On August 11, 2008, the Board was informed that, prospectively, Board approval would be sought when awarding contracts exceeding \$1 million in value if the OTRs are exercised. The contracts listed in the package were awarded prior to that date.**

Prior to exercising any Options-to-Renew (OTR) periods, market research is conducted to ensure that continuing to purchase from the awarded vendors is in the best interest of the County. Market research includes competitive factors such as pricing, quality, product features, technology, and lead time. It may also include commercial factors such as environmental issues, other governmental entity practices, industry trends, support and capabilities. The OTRs for each contract in this package will be executed if determined to be in the best interest of the County.

**Item No. 1: Sodium Permanganate** seeks authority to exercise the three remaining OTR periods for a contract to purchase sodium permanganate for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department. The amount being requested for the three remaining option terms is **\$3,252,000**.

**Item No. 2: Airfield Guidance Signs – Series L858** seeks to exercise the two remaining OTR periods for a contract to purchase airfield guidance signs for the Miami-Dade Aviation Department. The amount being requested for the two remaining option terms is **\$900,000**.

**Item No. 3: Various Food Items (Pre-qualification Pool)** seeks to exercise the two remaining OTR periods for a contract to purchase various food items for various County departments. The amount being requested for the two remaining option terms is **\$633,000**.

**Item No. 4: Uniforms for Various County Departments** seeks authority to exercise the two remaining OTR periods to purchase uniforms for various County departments. The amount being requested for the two remaining option terms is **\$756,364**.

**Item No. 5: Ice** seeks authority to exercise the two remaining OTR periods for a contract to purchase bagged ice for various County departments. The amount being requested for the two remaining option terms is **\$500,000**.

**Item No. 6: GIS Geodatabase Migration and Conversion** seeks authority to exercise the remaining OTR period for a contract to acquire professional services including project management, data conversion services, business process and software development assistance for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department. The amount being requested for the remaining option term is **\$400,000**.

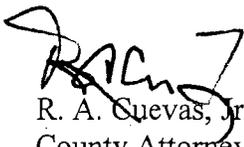

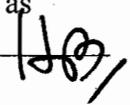

**Description:** It is recommended that the Board authorize the County Mayor or the County Manager's designee, to exercise the three remaining Option-to-Renew (OTR) periods for a contract to purchase sodium permanganate for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department. The contract is in the first OTR period which expires on August 14, 2009.

This contract was awarded on July 9, 2007 for a one-year period, with four, one-year OTRs with an allocation of \$849,664. On April 22, 2008, authorization was requested from the Board to exercise the remaining OTR periods. At that meeting, the Board authorized the approval of the first OTR period.

## JUSTIFICATION

Authorization is requested to exercise the remaining Option-to-Renew (OTR) period for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) to acquire professional services to support the GIS Geodatabase System.

This contract was established to provide WASD with a new geodatabase and applications that display existing water and sewer layers. The applications include the ability to edit, to conduct quality assurance and quality control, to generate maps and to prepare and format reports. One of the applications includes a web browser that will replace and enhance the existing Dade On-Line Facilities Information Network.

In order for a new vendor to provide support, it would require the new vendor to conduct in-depth business research and analysis. Additionally a new vendor would need to learn the new geodatabase, applications, and existing code developed by the current vendor. This would result in long delays to the project and added expense. In order to effectively support WASD's GIS Geodatabase migration, it is recommended that the County maintain the contract with the current vendor due to knowledge of WASD's systems and processes.

It is therefore recommended to exercise the only available OTR period under this contract.

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
