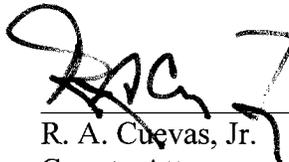

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commission is in recess during a period every year in August (the "summer recess"),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that as to County contracts that require the Board's approval and to the extent practicable, the County Mayor or his designee is hereby directed to establish the terms of County contracts so that such contracts do not expire during the Board's summer recess.
