

RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY OF MIAMI TO CO-DESIGNATE SW 32ND AVENUE FROM GRAND AVENUE TO DAY AVENUE AS “YVONNE M. MCDONALD ROAD” AND APPROVING SUCH DESIGNATION

WHEREAS, Yvonne M. McDonald grew up in Coconut Grove, where she later worked and played an integral part in making life better for the community; and

WHEREAS, McDonald dedicated her life to help others in spite of being legally blind from an early age; and

WHEREAS, McDonald was a dedicated public servant and an eloquent speaker, who always complimented those who deserved praise and encouraged those who needed guidance and help; and

WHEREAS, as a community activist, she provided counseling to families in need of housing, food, clothing and medical care, finding ways to immediately assist those in distress; and

WHEREAS, Yvonne M. McDonald passed away on Oct 14, 2008; and

WHEREAS, SW 32ND Avenue from Grand Avenue to Day Avenue is located in County Commission District 7 and is a city road located within the City of Miami,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the City of Miami to codesignate S.W. 32ND Avenue from Grand Avenue to Day Avenue as “Yvonne M. McDonald Road.”

Section 2. Approves the codesignation of S.W. 32ND Avenue from Grand Avenue to Day Avenue as “Yvonne M. McDonald Road.”

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Chair and Members of the Miami City Commission, the City Manager of the City of Miami, and the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department.
