Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) grant the attached Road Closing Petition following a public hearing. The Miami-Dade County Departments of Planning and Zoning, Public Works, Water and Sewer and Fire Rescue have no objection to this right-of-way being closed.

Scope

This road closing is located within the boundaries of Commission District 2.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The Property Appraiser's Office has assessed the adjacent property to this right-of-way at \$12.56 per square foot. Therefore, the estimated value of the right-of-way being closed would be approximately \$123,088.00. If this right-of-way is closed and vacated, the land will be placed on the tax roll, generating an estimated \$2,292 per year in additional property taxes. The fee for this road closing is \$13,108.80.

Track Record/Monitor

Not Applicable.

Background

The property owners abutting NW 29 Court, from NW 99 Street to NW 100 Street, have joined in signing the petition to close this right-of-way in order to incorporate the land into their property to be enhanced and maintained. The right-of-way being closed has never been improved nor maintained by Miami-Dade County. Therefore, this action will not adversely impact traffic flow or continuity of traffic in the area.

This right-of-way was dedicated in 1921, by the "AMENDED PLAT OF THE TROPICS", recorded in Plat Book 10, Page 17, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The subject right-of-way is zoned RU-1 (Single Family Residential District).

WHEREAS, the County Commission held a public hearing to consider a petition to close NW 29 Court, from NW 99 Street to NW 100 Street, as outlined in the accompanying petition and memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference ,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, (1) that the alley, avenue, street, road, highway or other place used for travel as described in the attached petition is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed, all rights of Miami-Dade County and the public in and to the same are hereby renounced and disclaimed; (2) it is found that the action will serve a public purpose and benefit the public without violating private property rights; (3) that the procedure utilized in the adoption of this resolution is expressly ratified and approved; and (4) the Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the adoption of this resolution one time within thirty (30) days hereafter in a newspaper of general circulation of Miami-Dade County.

The undersigned, pursuant to Sections 336.09 – 336.12 Florida Statutes, hereby petitions the Board of County Commissioners to vacate, abandon, discontinue and close an existing public street, alleyway, road, highway, or other place used for travel, or a portion thereof, and to renounce and disclaim any right of the County and the public in and to any land in connection therewith; or to renounce and disclaim any right of County and the public in and to certain land, or interest therein, acquired by purchase, gift, devise, dedication or prescription for street, alleyway, road or highway purposes; or to renounce and disclaim any right of the County and the public in and to certain land delineated on recorded map or plat as a street, alleyway, road or highway.

The undersigned hereby certify:

1. LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

That portion of NW 29th Court lying between Blocks 91 and 92, and limited by the north and the south extended lines of said blocks, of the AMENDED PLAT OF THE TROPICS, as recorded in Plat Book 10, Page 17, of the Public Records of Miami Dade County, Florida. Containing an area of 9,800 squared feet.



