Recommendation

This Request to Reject all Proposals for a Consultant Selection for Contract No. 20080029 has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval.

Scope

PROJECT NAME: Drainage Improvements to Caribbean Blvd. over the C-1N Canal Crossing

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Miami-Dade County PWD has the need to establish one (1) Non-exclusive Professional Services Agreement (PSA) to provide Planning, Design, and Post-Design Services in the preparation of complete construction documents for drainage improvements to Caribbean Blvd. at the C-1N Canal Crossing which will require the replacement of the existing bridge on Caribbean Blvd. spanning the C-1N Canal with a longer bridge that will not restrict the flow of the canal. The project shall include the complete replacement of the bridge. Scope of the work includes, roadway approaches, maintenance of traffic, utility impacts, survey, geotechnical testing, lighting, permitting, cost estimates, and any supportive tasks ancillary to the primary scope of service for a complete project.

EXPLANATION: At the February 20, 2009 First-Tier meeting, the Competitive Selection Committee (CSC) evaluated six (6) proposals received for this solicitation. Following the evaluation the CSC ranked the firms as follows:

1. BCC Engineering, Inc.
2. Network Engineering Services, Inc.
3. Sanchez-Zeinali & Associates, Inc.
4. Botas Engineering, Inc.
5. The Raul Puig Group, P.A.
6. Triangle Associates, Inc.

The CSC unanimously voted to waive Second-Tier proceedings, and recommended negotiations with BCC Engineering, Inc. as the top ranked firm, with Network Engineering Services, Inc. and Sanchez-Zeinali & Associates, Inc. as the first and second alternates, respectively.

The contract measure for this project is a 100% Set-aside for 1st Tier CBE firms. Pursuant to the CBE Participation Provisions, Section A. 32 states: "Set-aside means reservation for competition solely among first tier CBE-A/E's of given prime County agreements for architectural, landscape architectural, engineering, or surveying and mapping professional services." On February 26, 2009, SBD notified the five (5) firms of their non-compliance with the CBE Participation Provisions because of the inclusion of second-tier CBE firms in the proposal. On March 13, 2009 the firms were given an opportunity to appeal the decision. Two (2) firms chose not to appeal the non-compliant determination while the other three (3) firms provided no additional information or clarification during their meeting with SBD and therefore remained non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions.

On March 17, 2009, the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) received the Community Business Enterprise (CBE) compliance review from the Department of Small Business Development (SBD) for this solicitation. Five (5) of the six (6) firms, including the top ranked, were found to be non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions pursuant to the Notice to Professional Consultants (NTPC), advertised on December 2, 2008. On March 19, 2009 the Public Works Department (PWD) and the five (5) firms were notified accordingly by OCI of their non-compliance.

As a result of such determination, those five (5) firms are not eligible for further consideration and therefore will not be eligible to provide such services. Subsequently, the First-Tier ranking report was finalized to indicate that only one (1) firm is in compliance, Sanchez-Zeinali & Associates, Inc., ranked third by the CSC.

Pursuant to Chapter 287.055, Florida Statutes, and Section 2-10.4, Code of Miami-Dade County, no fewer than three (3) firms, in order of preference, shall be selected to be the most qualified to perform the required services. Because the only eligible proposal was ranked third and there is no other eligible proposer to ensure a competitive negotiation, PWD recommends that the sole remaining proposal be rejected and the project be re-advertised. On March 24, 2009 OCI notified all proposers of the County's intent to reject all proposals and to re-advertise the project via e-mail and certified mail.

Background

The proposed project will entail the replacement of an existing bridge spanning the C-1N canal with a longer bridge that does not restrict the flow of the canal.

The Department of Small Business Development (SBD) has completed its review of the above-referenced project for compliance with the Community Business Enterprise (CBE-A/E) Program for Architectural and Engineering Services. The contract measure established for this project is a 100% Set-aside for 1st Tier CBE firms.

The Professional Services Division of the Miami-Dade Office of Capital Improvements has submitted proposals from Botas Engineering, Inc. (#1), Network Engineering Services, Inc. (#2), The Raul Puig Group, P.A. (#3), Sanchez-Zeinalli & Associates, Inc. (#4), Triangle Associates, Inc. (#5), and BCC Engineering, Inc. (#6) for compliance review.

Botas Engineering, Inc. (#1) a certified first-tier CBE firm did not submit the required Letter of Agreement (for itself); however Botas Engineering submitted Letters of Agreement that listed the following: second-tier CBE sub-consultants Nova Consulting, Inc. to perform Highway System-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, Channelization, Highway Systems-Lighting, and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 10%, Geosol, Inc. to perform Drilling Subsurface Investigations & Seismographic and Geotechnical & Materials Engineering Services with no listed percentage, and Manuel G. Vera & Associates, Inc. to perform Surveying and Mapping-Land Surveying at 5%. Because of the inclusion of second-tier CBE firms, Botas Engineering, Inc. was notified of its non-compliance with the CBE Participations Provisions, and the opportunity to appeal such findings. Pursuant to Section A.32. of the CBE Participation Provisions: "Set-aside means reservation for competition solely among first tier CBE-A/Es of given prime County agreements for architectural, landscape architectural, engineering, or surveying and mapping professional services." Botas Engineering chose not to appeal the non-compliant determination; therefore, Botas Engineering, Inc. remains non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions.

Network Engineering Services, Inc. (#2) a certified second-tier CBE firm submitted the required Letter of Agreement listing itself to perform Highway Systems-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Bridge Design, and Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization at 65%. Network Engineering also submitted Letters of Agreement that listed the following: first-tier CBE sub-consultants Alvarez Engineers, Inc. to perform Highway Systems-Lighting and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 20% and C.H. Perez & Associates Consulting Engineers, Inc. to perform Surveying and Mapping-Land Surveying at 5%; and, second-tier CBE sub-consultant Geosol, Inc. to perform Drilling Subsurface Investigations & Seismographic and Geotechnical & Materials Engineering Services at 10%. Because of the inclusion of second-tier CBE firms, Network Engineering Services, Inc. was notified of its non-compliance with the CBE Participations Provisions, and the opportunity to appeal such findings. Pursuant to Section A.32. of the CBE Participation Provisions: "Set-aside means reservation for competition solely among first tier CBE-A/Es of given prime County agreements for architectural, landscape architectural, engineering, or surveying and mapping professional services." Network Engineering Services chose not to appeal the non-compliant determination; therefore, Network Engineering Services, Inc. remains non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions.

The Raul Puig Group, P.A. (#3) a certified second-tier CBE firm submitted the required Letter of Agreement listing itself to perform Highway Systems-Bridge Design at 56%. The Raul Puig Group also submitted Letters of Agreement that listed the following: first-tier CBE sub-consultants CRJ & Associates, Inc. to perform Highway System-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization, and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 25%, Initial Engineers, P.A. to perform Highway Systems-Lighting at 7%, Triangle Surveying & Mapping, Inc. to perform Surveying and Mapping-Land Surveying at 6%, and second-tier CBE sub-consultant Kaderabek Company to perform Drilling Subsurface Investigations & Seismographic and Geotechnical & Materials Engineering Services at 6%. Because of the inclusion of second-tier CBE firms, The Raul Puig Group was notified of its non-compliance with the CBE Participations Provisions, and the opportunity to appeal such findings. Pursuant to Section A.32. of the CBE Participation Provisions: "Set-aside means reservation for competition solely among first tier CBE-A/Es of given prime County agreements for architectural, landscape architectural, engineering, or surveying and mapping professional services." No additional information or clarification was provided during the meeting of March 13, 2009 between SBD and The Raul Group; therefore, The Raul Puig Group, P.A. remains non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions.

Sanchez-Zeinali & Associates, Inc. (#4) a certified first-tier CBE firm submitted the required Letter of Agreement listing itself to perform Highway Systems-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Bridge Design, and Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization at 67.5%. Sanchez-Zeinali also submitted Letters of Agreement that listed first-tier CBE sub-consultants Alvarez Engineers, Inc. to perform Highway Systems-Lighting and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 12.5%, HP Consultants, Inc. to perform Drilling Subsurface Investigations & Seismographic and Geotechnical & Materials Engineering Services at 10%, and P (3) S M, LLC to perform Surveying and Mapping-Land Surveying, also at 10%. Sanchez-Zeinali & Associates, Inc. is in compliance with the CBE Participation Provisions.

Triangle Associates, Inc. (#5) a certified first-tier CBE firm submitted the required Letter of Agreement listing itself to perform Highway Systems-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Bridge Design, Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization, and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 60%. Triangle Associates also submitted Letters of Agreement that listed the following: first-tier CBE sub-consultants Civil Works, Inc. to perform Highway Systems-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Lighting, Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization, and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services at 15%, Robayna and Associates, Inc. to perform Highway Systems-Highway Design, Highway Systems-Bridge Design, Highway Systems-Signing, Pavement Markings, and Channelization, and Environmental Engineering-Stormwater Drainage Design Services also at 15%, Hadonne Corporation to perform Surveying and Mapping-Land Surveying at 5%, and second-tier CBE sub-consultant Geosol, Inc. to perform Drilling Subsurface Investigations & Seismographic and Geotechnical & Materials Engineering Services at 5%. Because of the inclusion of second-tier CBE firms, Triangle Associates was notified of its non-compliance with the CBE Participations Provisions, and the opportunity to appeal such findings. Pursuant to Section A.32. of the CBE Participation Provisions: "Set-aside means reservation for competition solely among first tier CBE-A/Es of given prime County agreements for architectural, landscape architectural, engineering, or surveying and mapping professional services." No additional information or clarification was provided during the meeting of March 13, 2009 between SBD and Triangle Associates, Inc.; therefore, Triangle Associates, Inc. remains non-compliant with the CBE Participation Provisions.

BCC Engineering, Inc. 

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



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Miami-Dade County Public Works Department has the need to establish one (1) Non-exclusive Professional Services Agreement (PSA) to provide Planning, Design, and Post-Design Services in the preparation of complete construction documents for drainage improvements to Caribbean Blvd at the C-1N Canal Crossing which will require the replacement of the existing bridge on Caribbean Blvd spanning the C-1N Canal with a longer bridge that will not restrict the flow of the canal.
