



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE JUNE 27, 2009 "CAN ANYTHING GOOD COME OUT OF THE HOOD: COMMUNITY EXPO & FAMILY FEST" SPONSORED BY THE INNER CITY YOUTH OF SOUTH FLORIDA-YOUTH ATHLETIC LEAGUE, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,675.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND



## Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allow for funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization, the Inner City Youth of South Florida – Youth Athletic League, Inc., for their “Can Anything Good Come Out of the Hood: Community Expo & Family Fest” event held on June 27, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$2,675 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the use of a 24’X40’ stage, medium showmobile and two (2) light towers. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, Inner City Youth of South Florida – Youth Athletic League, Inc., received no county funding for this event.
