

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE JUNE 20, 2009 "WORLD REFUGEE DAY" SPONSORED BY INTERNATIONAL RESCUE COMMITTEE, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,400.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, International Rescue Committee, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Police Department for the June 20, 2009 "World Refugee Day" in an amount not to exceed \$1,400.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "World Refugee Day" is a free event for refugee families which includes, among other things, health screenings, on-site assistance with the Social Security Administration and recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, International Rescue Committee, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "World Refugee Day" is a special event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,400.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,



Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization, International Rescue Committee, Inc., for their "World Refugee Day" event held on June 20, 2009.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$1,400 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2008-09, International Rescue Committee, Inc., received no county funding for this event.
